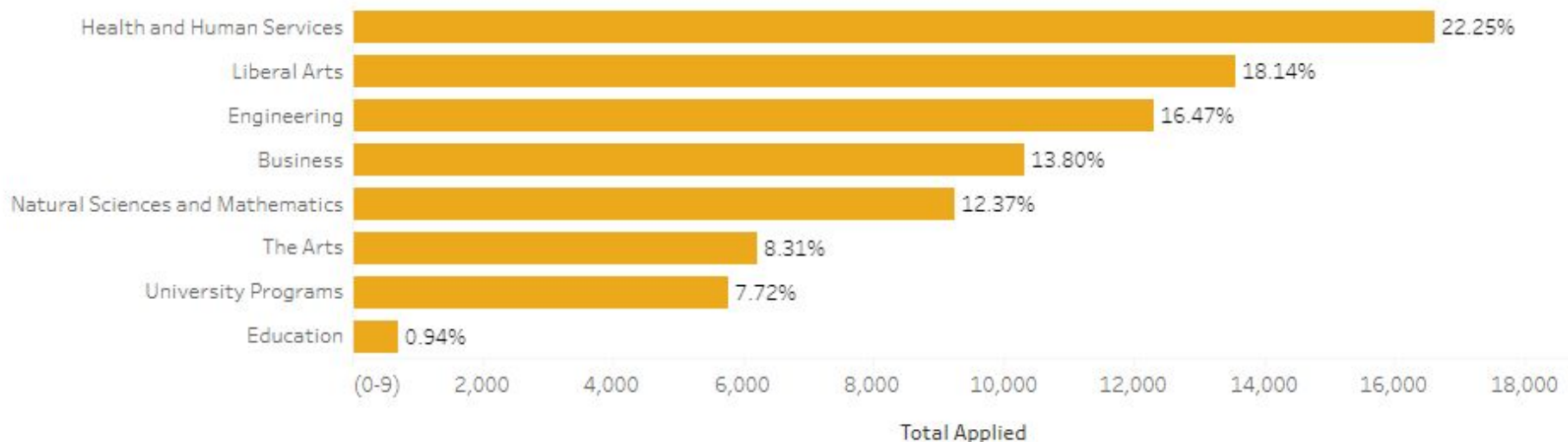

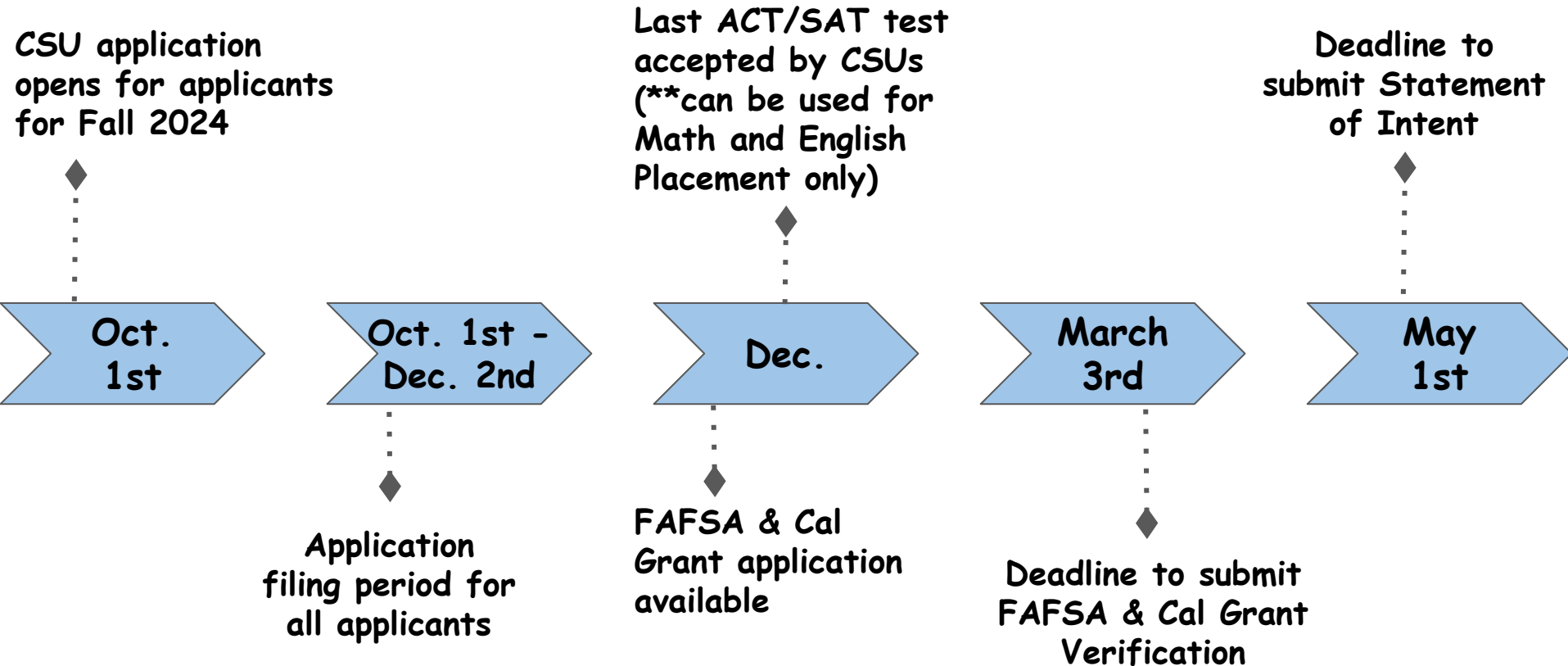

## Student Brag Sheet

### STUDENT INFORMATION FORM FOR LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

If you need a Letter of Recommendation from your counselor/teacher, for a college application, a scholarship program or some other activity, you need to complete this form. Remember that the counselor writing your recommendation wants to do a good job for you, so it's important that you follow all directions on the following list.

#### REQUIREMENTS FOR LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION:

\_\_\_ Write a statement about your strengths and unique gifts. Be sure to use personal experiences to illustrate ideas. Do include copy of college essay.

\_\_\_ Complete this Counselor/Teacher Letter of Recommendation Form. Include as much information as possible. Use a separate piece of paper if necessary. The style and form of these statements are not of great importance but the content, quality, and specific examples are. Be as comprehensive as possible. Your recommender will appreciate the information and will be able to write a stronger letter for you.

\_\_\_ Return student statement and completed form to counselor/teacher(s) writing recommendation.

\_\_\_ Order transcript through Registrar's office.

Remember to **thank** the person writing your recommendation.

# FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA)

- **FAFSA**
  - Opens: December 1, 2024
  - Deadline to apply: March 3, 2025
  - The earlier you apply the better, some school based aid is competitive and can run out
  - Ensure you are applying for the 2025 - 2026 FAFSA

# **Free APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA)**

## **Replacing the Expected Family Contribution (EFC) with the Student Aid Index (SAI)**

Students and families will see a different measure of their ability to pay for college and will also experience a change in the methodology used to determine aid. The new formula removes the number of family members in college from the calculation and allows a minimum SAI of negative \$1,500 to give financial aid administrators more insight when making determinations for students with especially challenging situations.

# **CAL GRANT GPA**

- **Ayala electronically submits a list of ALL SENIOR verified GPAs directly to the California Student Aid Commission (CSAC) by the March 3, 2025 deadline**
  - A record of senior names and GPAs submitted to CSAC is kept in the counseling office
  - Any new seniors that enroll after October 1, 2024, please contact Mrs. Cabrera, in the counseling office, to ensure that a Cal Grant GPA is submitted.

- Available October 1 (check individual schools for deadlines)
- Students who complete CSS application must also complete FAFSA to receive Federal Aid

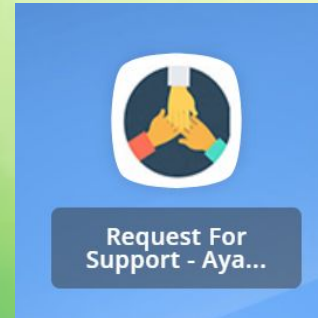
