

WHAT IS AVID?

- AVID stands for **Advancement Via Individual Determination**
- AVID is an in-school **college readiness program** for grades 9-12 that prepares students for college eligibility and success
- It is a **global program** (currently in 16 other countries)



WHO IS AVID FOR?

❖ AVID is for ALL students, but targets students who are:

- Highly motivated
- 1st generation
- Historically underserved
- Or have special circumstances

❖ AVID is not an AT RISK program

- Students must have GPA of 2.0 or above




