

CHHS Incoming Freshmen Counseling Dept. FAQ



1. When will the Academic Plan/Aeries portal be open?

The Academic Plan will be open for incoming freshmen until April 14, 2025. You will need to switch your profile to your student's high school profile and not Junior High. Please make sure to "Submit Plan for Counselor Approval". *Academic Plan Instructions:* Online Course Request via Academic Plan

3. What is a typical 9th grade schedule?

College Prep Track: English 9 CP IM1 BioLivingEarth VPA Health/World Geo/
FreshmenTransition PE

Honors Level Track: English 9H IM 1 or IM2H* BioLivingEarth H Language 1 Health/World Geo/
Freshmen Transition PE

*Dependent on math placement & 8th grade completion of IM1

**Final course placement will be made by counselors based upon past academic performance & testing information

4. Can freshmen take AP courses?

Freshmen are allowed to take AP Human Geography if they are currently enrolled in & plan to take English Honors.

5. When is Freshman Orientation?

Freshmen Orientation (led by LinkCrew Club) will take place around registration. (see CHHS page during summer for update)

6. When is registration?

Registration for next school year will be at the end of July/early August. You will receive notification of which date your student needs to come in for registration via email. If your student misses registration & makeup date, they will need to complete the registration process during the first week of school. (see CHHS page during summer for update.)

7. When will my student know if they have been accepted to: ASB, Leadership, HSA, BAHT, AVID, PLUS?

Accepted students will be contacted by programs by mail or email.

8. Can I be in Athletic PE?

Athletic PE is placed by counselors based off of Coach's Roster- Varsity only. Not all sports will have Athletic PE. If you are planning on joining a sport, please select regular PE 9 first.

9. Can I meet with my counselor?

Due to time constraints and current case loads, counselors are unable to meet individually with any incoming student (aside from [scheduled Jr. High Counselor visit dates](#)).

10. Can I change my schedule?

After meeting with CHHS counselors on Jr. High visit date (feeder schools) or selecting classes through Google Form (non-feeder), you will not be able to make any changes to your course request. You will be able to request changes in the beginning of 1st semester (first 2 weeks) based on space availability. **The only reason for class change will be level placement. NO CHANGES FOR: teacher preference, period preference, or elective choice change.**

11. Can I take summer school?

Our counselors will not be approving any incoming freshmen/ transfer students to take summer school and can only approve current students. Incoming students can take [Chaffey Dual Enrollment](#) or [Baldy View ROP](#) courses if they are interested in enrichment.
