

SAT and ACT

- The UC and CSU system are NOT requiring the SAT or ACT for admission.
- Some private and out-of-state schools DO require the tests.
- ▶ Fee waivers available for those who qualify.
- The next SAT will be offered on March 8, 2025. Spaces do fill up. Register by 2/21/25 at www.collegeboard.org
- The ACT will be offered February 8. The deadline to register is 1/20/2025. You can sign up or get more information at <u>www.act.org</u>
- Chino Hills High is not a test center. Testing centers are listed on College Board's and ACT's website.


