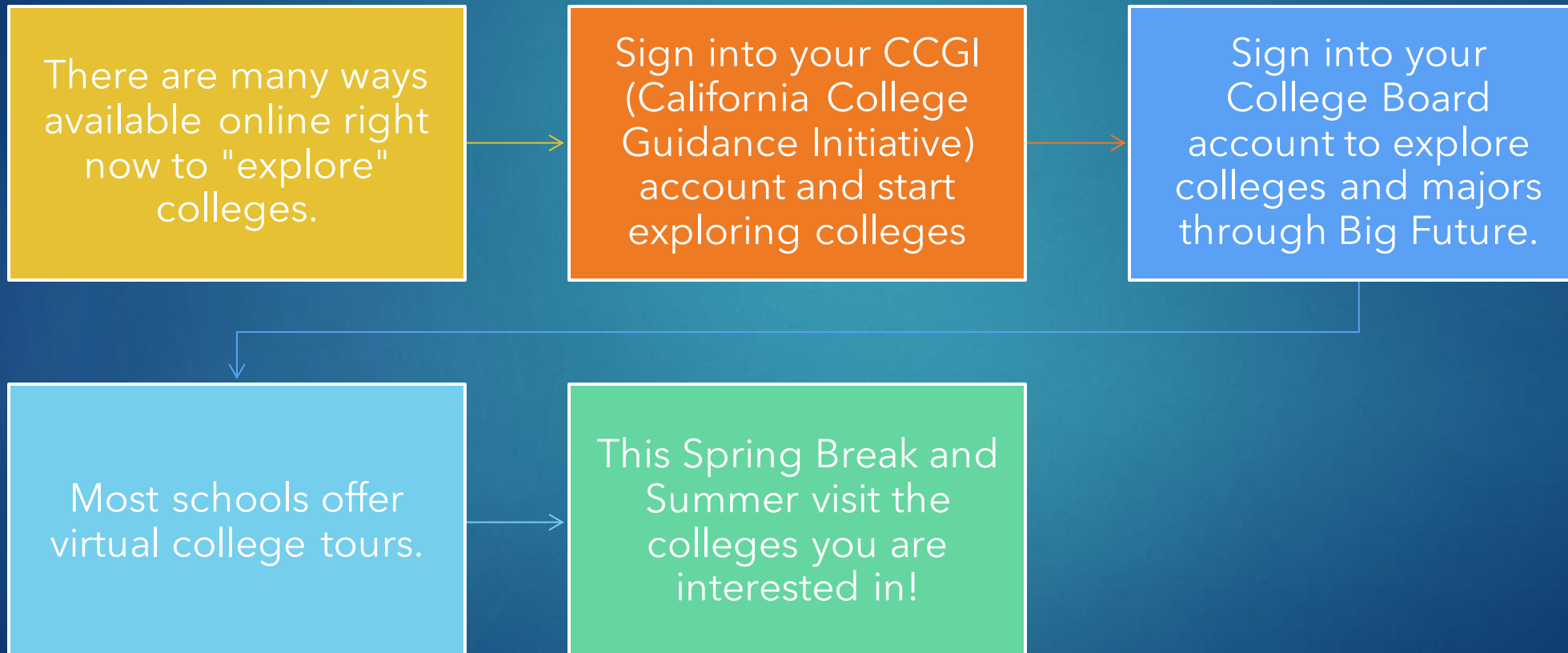


SAT and ACT

- ▶ The UC and CSU system are NOT requiring the SAT or ACT for admission.
- ▶ Some private and out-of-state schools DO require the tests.
- ▶ Fee waivers available for those who qualify.
- ▶ The next SAT will be offered on March 9. Spaces do fill up. Register by 2/1/24 at www.collegeboard.org
- ▶ The ACT will be offered February 10. The deadline to register is 1/22/2024. You can sign up or get more information at www.act.org
- ▶ Chino Hills High is not a test center. Testing centers are listed on College Board's and ACT's website.

AP Night


- ▶ AP night will be held on Monday January 30th at 6:00 pm.

- ▶ Courses get a GPA bonus point on UC/CSU college applications. (Like AP courses.)
- ▶ One semester fulfills a one-year A-G requirement.
