
For REQUIRED personal insight questions (see <u>link</u> for additional information)

- They are looking for context, show your personality,
 BE YOU!
- AVOID: Talking about a specific campus, Poems, Quotes,
 Acronyms, Repetition.
- These questions give you the opportunity to informally interview with the UCs and reflect your individual circumstances.



Requesting Transcripts for College App

If you attended ONLY Chino Hills High School:

- You will list only Chino Hills HS in your applications
- Send a transcript from Chino Hills HS via Parchment.com





If you attended **Any** of the below schools:

Imagine Learning Excellence Academy, Mt. SAC, Mission Academy, BYU, Silicon Valley, and/or any other online school, another high school or school outside the US:

- You will list <u>ALL</u> schools in your applications
- Send a transcript from <u>ALL</u> schools to college even if classes are listed on Chino Hills HS transcript

<u>Attendance</u>

- <u>California Truancy Law</u> defines a truant as a child who, without a valid excuse is:
 - *absent for 3 full days in a single year
 - *tardy 3 times in a year
 - *absent for 3 times for more than 30 minutes, or
 - o *any combination of the above.

FAFSA

The <u>Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)</u> is the form you need to fill out to get any financial aid from the federal government to help pay for college. Each year, over 13 million students who file the FAFSA get more than \$120 billion in grants, work-study, and low-interest loans from the U.S. Department of Education.

Many states and colleges also use the FAFSA to determine which students get financial aid—and how much they'll get.

The FAFSA asks for information about you and your family's finances, including tax returns, so you might need your parents' help to complete it. If you need additional help, reach out to your school counselor.

Who Should fill out the FAFSA? Everyone!!

- Each year, millions—sometimes billions—of dollars in federal aid is left on the table by students who didn't file a FAFSA. It's simple: If you don't file, you won't qualify for most financial aid.
- Your family doesn't have to have a low income to qualify for assistance.
 Even if your family makes \$200,000 a year, you could be eligible for aid.
- You automatically qualify for a low-interest federal loan when you submit a FAFSA. These loans are less expensive to pay back than many private student loans.
- Many work-study programs require the FAFSA.
- Some merit-based scholarships require the FAFSA to help them determine scholarship amounts.

CAL GRANT PROGRAMS

The Cal Grant is a California-specific financial aid allocation that does not need to be paid back. Cal Grant applicants must apply using the FAFSA or CA Dream Act Application by the deadline and meet all eligibility, financial, and minimum GPA requirements of either program. Grants are for students attending Universities of California, California State Universities or California Community Colleges, or qualifying independent and career colleges or technical schools in California.

There are three kinds of Cal Grants — A, B and C — but you don't have to figure out which one to apply for. Your eligibility will be based on your FAFSA or CA Dream Act Application responses, your verified Cal Grant GPA, the type of California colleges you list on your application and whether you're a recent high school graduate.


