

# HOMEWORK EXPECTATIONS

Homework is a great opportunity to practice and master the skills that were learned in class. It must be done in PENCIL and kept organized in your notebook or binder.

## PROPER HEADINGS:

- Assignment number on the upper right-hand corner
- Assignment title on the top line of the page
  - Title is the “name” of the assignment
    - Wkst-name of the worksheet
    - Book assignment-problem set (ex: pg 55 (1-10))

## BODY OF HOMEWORK:

- Homework problems must be organized
- Homework must start on the right hand side of your notebook
- ALL directions and questions must be written down and all figures drawn (unless told otherwise)
- All problems must be written down and numbered (yes, even the word problems unless told otherwise)
- All problems must be worked out with ALL WORK shown VERTICALLY
- Problems must go in ascending order vertically down the page
- Final answer must be boxed or highlighted.
  - Exceptions are tables, graphs, etc.
- Skip a line after EVERY problem

## HOMEWORK CORRECTING

- Homework answers will be posted on my website
- Answers need to be checked once you are DONE with your homework and corrected
  - Your homework grade is NOT affected by incorrect answers, so don't be afraid to make mistakes/corrections
- After the warm-up problem (in class) you will have an opportunity to go over the homework with your partners (which is why you must check the answers beforehand!!)

## SUBMISSIONS

- Homework must be submitted through Google Classroom as one PDF
  - Homework that is submitted as multiple PDFs or as something other than a PDF will not be considered submitted and will be given a score of 0
  - Homework that is illegible or a scan that is not visible will not be considered submitted and will be given a score of 0

## GRADING

- One point for the correct headings (see above)
- One point for correct body set up (folded in half, directions, etc)
- One point for each completed homework problem
- One point for questions and directions written down
- Final score will be given as a percentage 0%-100%

\*Late work must be finished and accompanied by a HW or OOPS pass
