

INTERACTIVE NOTEBOOK EXPECTATIONS AND GRADING

Your notebook must be correctly organized (All sections in order) and reasonably legible (your partner should be able to read your notes as if they were their own). **Notebooks are collected at the beginning of each test day.**

TABLE OF CONTENTS:

You are required to have a table of contents for each unit. This aides in organization as well as being able to quickly see where certain concepts may be. The following must be included:

1. The unit title
2. Section title
3. The objectives for each section

SECTIONS:

Each section must have the following criteria:

1. Every section must be in order
2. All handouts must be taped securely in notebook in the correct orientation
3. Notes need to be complete, correct, organized and legible
