School Board names new administrators

Two new principals, four assistant principals, and an interim assistant principal were appointed June 25 by the Chino Valley Unified School District (CVUSD) Board of Education.

Thomas Rummell will be Wickman Elementary School's new principal, replacing Don Wilson who retired this summer.

Karen Morales, a former assistant principal at Walnut Avenue Elementary School in Chino, will be Walnut's new principal.

New assistant principals and their campuses are Ashley Barnett, Woodcrest Junior High in Ontario; Shauna White and Kristina Gentry, Magnolia Junior High in Chino; and Renae Ramsey, Butterfield Ranch Elementary School in Chino Hills.

Trevor Carenzo will be interim assistant principal at Hidden Trails Elementary School in Chino Hills. Rummell joined CVUSD in 1999 as a third grade teacher at Butterfield Ranch Elementary.
