Diplomas will be ordered soon The potential graduation list is posted outside in the quad area. Your diploma will be ordered exactly as your name appears on the list. Please check the spelling of your name. If any change is needed, you will need to make the change in the Records Office (before school, after school or at lunch).

All California public high schools are required to submit a Cal Grant high school GPA for all graduating seniors, unless the student or parent has opted out of the submission process. If you do NOT want Chino High School to report your GPA next year, come to the Counseling Office to see Mrs. Rodriguez (Counseling Assistant) to get a Cal Grant GPA Opt-Out Form. As a reminder, if a parent chooses to opt-out their student from the GPA submission process, the student will not be eligible to receive State financial aid for college. Please make sure to return the completed form to Mrs. Rodriguez no later than January 31st.
