

INCOMING 9TH GRADER FAQS

- Can I make an appointment with my student's counselor?
 - Counselors will be available for appointments beginning August 2023
 - Please see the <u>Chino High Counseling Webpage</u> for graduation requirements, A-G requirements, and course descriptions.
- When will my student receive his/her schedule?
 - Students are currently able to view their course requests in Aeries. Teachers, periods, and classroom assignments will be posted in the student's Aeries portal the weekend prior to the first day of school.
- How can I change my schedule?
 - Students will be assigned a day to come to campus at Chino High School before the start of school in August where counselors will be available to discuss related concerns and to make course changes during this time. Information will be sent to your home over the summer.
- How can I change a teacher or period assignment?
 - No period or teacher requests are permitted.
- Do I have to take PE in the 9th grade?
 - Yes, all incoming freshmen must take PE 9/Athletic PE/ PE Band/ PE Pageantry unless they are enrolled in a special program (such as AVID or Leadership) where they are deemed to have an "impacted schedule". In this case, students will need to be approved to take PE over the summer or outside of the regular school year.
- How does my student register for sports, band, leadership or AVID?

- My student is on a sports team. Will she/he be in Athletic PE?
 - To be admitted into Athletic PE for a sport a coach must approve a student to take part in the class.
 Not all sports have Athletic PE, and usually only Varsity athletes are approved for Athletic PE.
 Counselors will receive rosters prior to school starting with students approved to take Athletic PE in the fall and again before spring semester begins.
