Monthly Reminders

Learning at Home –

Language Arts: Studies show that children are exposed to a larger variety of words in children's books that are read to them than from what they hear on television or streamed movies. That means anything you read to them will enlarge their vocabulary much more than the conversational dribble heard on television.

Remember that your child's listening vocabulary is much larger than his/her reading vocabulary. When you read books that are interesting to him/her, both reading and writing vocabularies increase. That's because if she/he has heard a word before in context, then when it's presented in the classroom, she'll/he'll be able to recognize it with greater comprehension. – Taken from K12 Reader.com

Math: With Singapore Math (as taught through Pearson: K-5, and Big Ideas: 6th), your goal as a parent should be to support and encourage the style of math learning that works for them in solving the problems. "The parent is the supporter. The parent is the guide in asking questions," Forsten (a math consultant) says. "I believe the best thing they can do is question their children. Questioning children is an excellent way to develop their thinking." So when your daughter or son comes home with a math problem that you don't understand, simply ask what they know about it, what they were taught in school, how they would solve the problems, the explanation for the solutions, and so on. – Taken from the PBS Education Newsletter
