<u>CLASSROOM RULES/CONSEQUENCES:</u> Our Math Department will enforce the School-Wide Classroom Behavior expectations as outlined in the agenda. (BE SAFE, BE RESPECTFUL, BE RESPONSIBLE)

The student will have the number of days absent to make up daily assignments.
