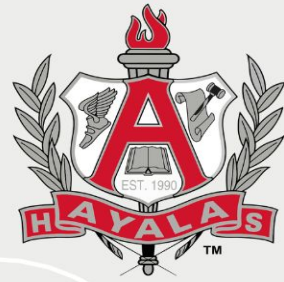

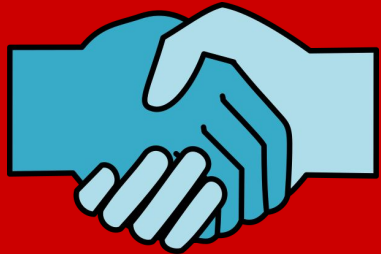
TURNING IN WORK

STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO:

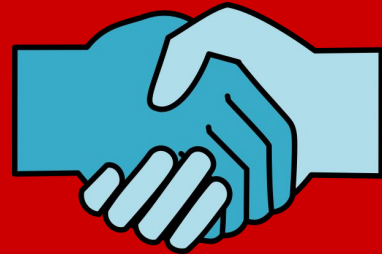
- READ & FOLLOW DIRECTIONS THOROUGHLY

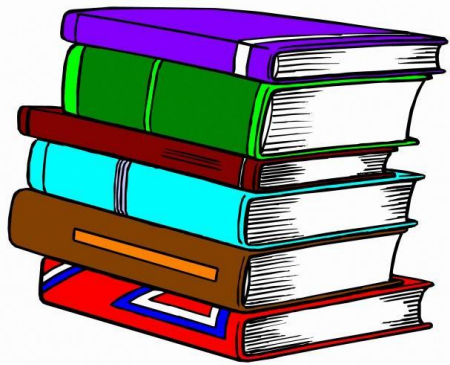
