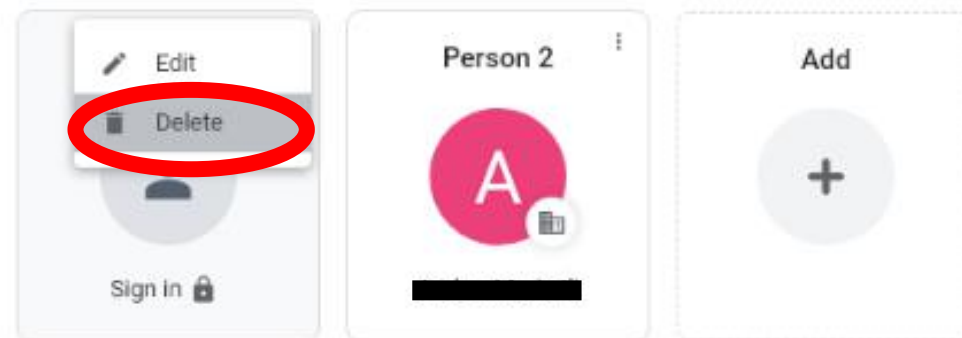
Once you open CHROME, it will look like this. But if you only have 2 boxes, don't worry, and continue. Once you delete "Person 1" your box will appear

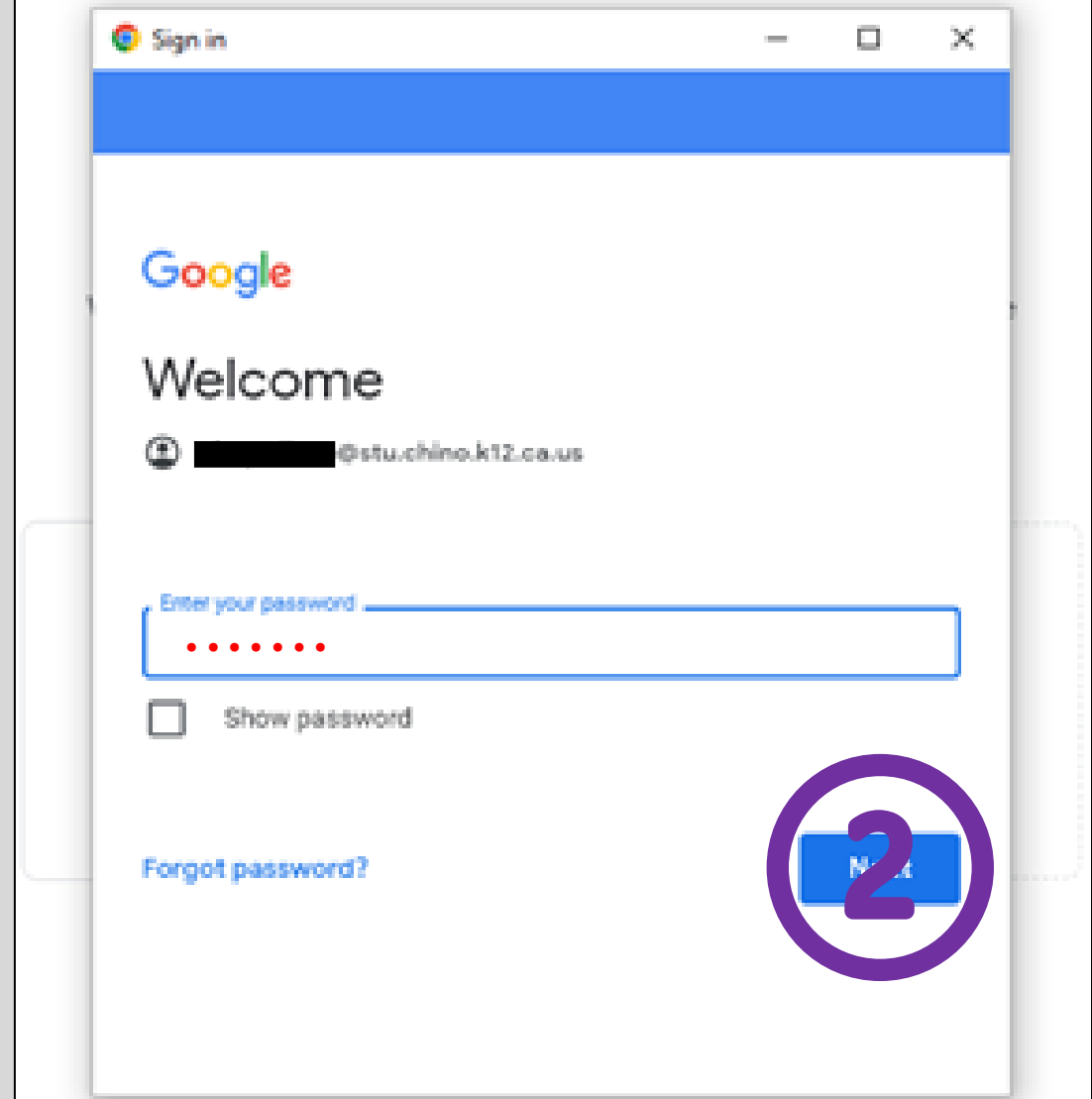
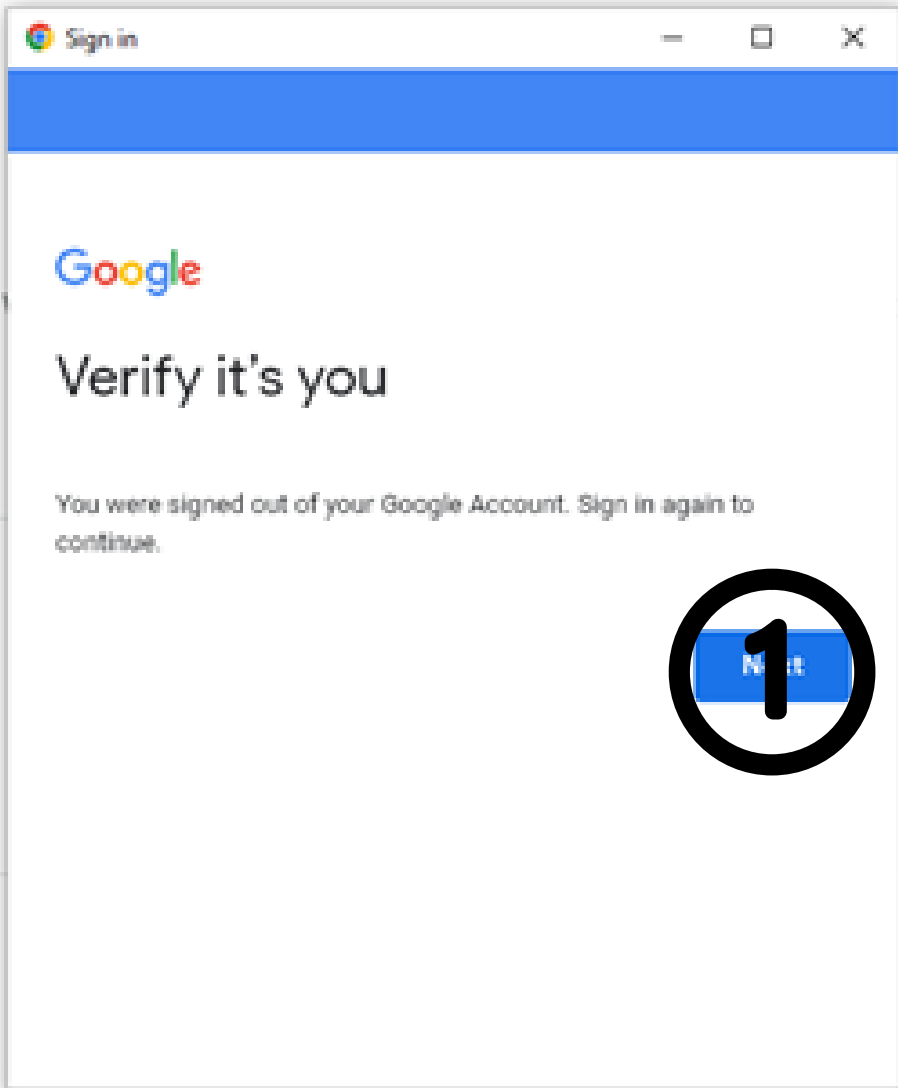

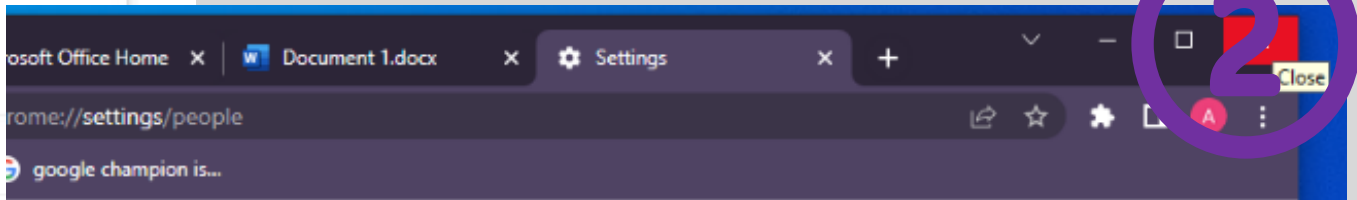
