Class Rules

1. Students will respect the teacher and all fellow classmates at all times. Students must come prepared to class if not, they may lose participation points or not participate in class/lab that day.

2. Cell phone, iPad, laptop, or music player use is absolutely NOT permitted unless during a class activity that involves those electronic devices. If the student does NOT store the phone away in the backpack when asked and is caught later using the phone during class, the phone will be confiscated and taken to the front office so it can be picked up at the end of the school day. 3. Late work is absolutely NOT accepted. If a student is absent, they will have one day per one day of EXCUSED absence to get it in. It is the student's responsibility to gather and complete all the work that was missed during their absence or a zero will be given. If the absence is NOT EXCUSED, no work will be accepted.

Make-up quizzes/tests are given ONLY the following day after the scheduled quiz/test during LUNCH. If the students fails to come in to make up the quiz/test, then they will automatically receive a zero.

4. Food and drinks must be placed in the student's backpack. Food is not allowed to be out or eaten during class, especially during labs. This is a SAFETY hazard and will be strictly enforced for the safety of the students.

Disciplinary Plan

Please read the following carefully; Students misbehaving in the classroom will be handled accordingly:

First Offense: Student will receive a warning.

Second Offense: Student will have a one-on-one conference with the teacher and an email will be set to the parent/guardian.

Third Offense: Student will complete an in-class personal behavior evaluation and a one-on-one conference with the teacher. The teacher will also email the parent/guardian, and inform them that this is the third and final offense before being sent to administration

Fourth Offense: The student will automatically will be excused from the classroom with a referral to Administration, which may result, but is not limited to, a class suspension.

Please note: If student poses as a threat to the safety of the classroom, or displays extreme levels of unacceptable behavior, this may result in an automatic detention, referral to administration, or a suspension.

Classroom Policies

<u>Bathroom Policy</u>: Students must have a hall pass, as well as take the classroom bathroom pass. They will be given a maximum of 5 minutes to use the restroom. They will have to sign in & sign out on the bathroom sheet. If students do not sign in and out legibly and accordingly, they may lose their bathroom privileges altogether. There is no bathroom use during the first and last 10 minutes of class.

<u>Lab Safety</u>: This is a laboratory class, therefore the students are working with expensive equipment and/or toxic chemicals. Due to this, the students will be responsible for lab safety test, preparing for labs by writing down the procedure, and much more. If the students fails to properly prepare for a lab, they will automatically receive a zero for the lab, and not participate in the lab as well. It is extremely important that the students come prepared to handle chemicals and the equipment.

Cheating/Academic Dishonesty

Any student who is caught cheating, plagiarizing, or breaks the code of academic honesty will automatically receive a referral to administration and receive a zero on that assignment/test. Any type of copying work, giving work to be copied, improving someone's score on peer evaluation, or violating test conditions are all forms of cheating. Academic dishonesty will become part of a student's permanent record, which may result in a guidance counselor or teacher not being able to write a letter of recommendation for colleges. During testing students phones will be on the desk and turned OFF. If it goes off the student will receive a zero.
