Dear CVUSD Parents and Guardians,

Thank you for continuing to keep our students at home when they are sick or suspected of having COVID-19. Please continue to screen students at home each morning, prior to them arriving on campus.

While at school, if your child experiences one high risk or two or more low risk symptoms listed by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), California Department of Public Health (CDPH), and San Bernardino County Department of Public Health (SBCDPH) as symptoms for the novel coronavirus, COVID-19, you will be notified to pick up your child.

Low-risk Symptoms		High-risk Symptoms
Fever (100.4° F or greater)	Fatigue	Loss of Taste or Smell
Chills	Congestion	New and persistent/uncontrolled cough
Nausea	Runny Nose	Shortness of breath and/or difficulty breathing
Vomiting	Sore Throat	
Diarrhea	Muscle / Body Aches	
Headache		

The CDC recognizes that these symptoms are associated with multiple illnesses that may not be related to COVID-19. We are unable to definitively determine if these symptoms are related to COVID-19 or another diagnosis. **If there was no exposure to a COVID-19 positive person**, the following criteria needs to be met by the student before returning to school:

1. At least 24 hours have passed without fever and fever reducing medication
2. Other symptoms have improved

One of the following is recommended, but not required:

- Health care provider confirms an alternative diagnosis for symptoms or an underlying condition (a health care provider's note should be on file at school) OR
- Negative Antigen test (preferred) or SARS-CoV-2 PCR (verification of results is not required) OR
- 10 days have passed since symptoms first developed

If your student does test positive for COVID-19, please contact your school office. For all other questions, including student exposures to a positive case outside of school, contact COVID support (COVIDSupport@chino.k12.ca.us).

Thank you for your assistance as we strive to make our school a safe place for students and staff.
