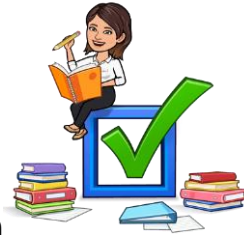

Students will be able to:

Scan for pertinent information in simple life-skill materials.

Read and demonstrate understanding of short, simplified paragraphs on familiar topics containing previously learned vocabulary and sentence patterns.

## WRITING

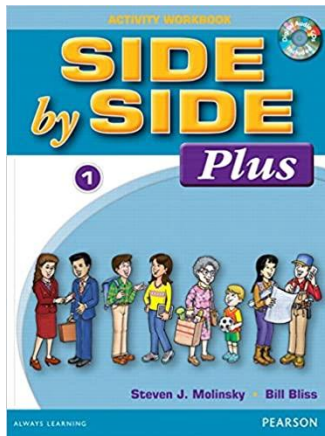
Students will be able to:

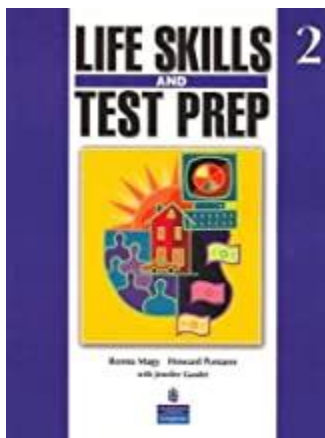
