Woodcrest JHS has implemented the PBIS (Positive Behavior Support) program for student discipline. The PBIS program works to reward students that are making Positive Behavioral choices. By following the three basic principles, Be Responsible, Be Respectful, and Be Safe, students can easily avoid problems and be successful on our campus. Students are expected to demonstrate the appropriate behaviors at all times on campus, at school activities, and to and from school.

Agendas: Students are required to bring their agendas with them to school every day as this is where we record the assignments, their due dates, and any announcements.

Grading:

- Effective use of class time – Turning in classwork/homework – 40%
- Tests and quizzes - 60%

Grading Scale	
90% - 100%	= A
80% - 89%	= B
70% - 79%	= C
60% - 69%	= D
0% - 59%	= F

As this is a high school course, students are required to have at least a 70% at the end of the grading cycle to get high school credit for the class.

Turning in Work: Students will turn in their work in class on the date that it is due. All assignments will be posted in Teams but need to be done on paper. **WORK MUST BE SHOWN ON THE ASSIGNMENTS FOR CREDIT!**

Late Work: Late work may be turned in until the end of the chapter for full credit. Once the chapter is finished and we have taken the test, all missing work are recorded as “Zeros” (no credit). Do not abuse this policy!!
