Course Description

In the **CS Discoveries** class, students will be expected to type in class for 10 minutes each day using the website typing.com. Typing tests will be given every 6 weeks. Students will learn about internet safety and how to use the internet for research. They will learn the parts of the computer and what is their function. They will also do coding through the website code.org. Topics to be covered in coding will be web design, animations, and designing simple programs.

Attendance:

All work will be completed on the computer. Students will turn in work either through their Microsoft Teams notebook or through Code.org. Assignments will be uploaded to Teams on the day they are assigned.

Late Work:

Late work may be turned in until the **end of the grading period** for <u>full credit</u>. Once the assignment due date has passed, all missing work is recorded as "Zeros" (no credit) until the work is turned in. When you turn in late work, it is **your responsibility** to let me know by filling out a "late work" form and turning that in to me. Do not abuse this policy!!
