


Turn on select-to-speak




Step 1 of 9

At the bottom right, select the time. Or press **Alt + Shift + s**.




Step 2 of 9

Select Settings .




Step 3 of 9

On the left, select **Advanced** > **Accessibility**.




Step 4 of 9

In the "Accessibility" section, select **Manage accessibility features**.




Step 5 of 9

Under "Text-to-Speech," turn on **Enable select-to-speak**.




Step 6 of 9

To select what text you'd like to hear: Highlight the text and press **Search Q + s**.




Step 7 of 9

To select what text you'd like to hear: Or you can press **Search**  + click or tap a line of text or drag the pointer or your finger over an area of the screen.




Step 8 of 9
