Classroom Minor Discipline Citation

Use at least three classroom interventions and document minor behaviors



Does the student have 3 or more incidents and have documented parent contact attempts?

*Classroom report doesn't need to be for the same behavior.



Write office referral and send copy of classroom incident log to the office during non-instructional time

□ 5:1 positive praise □ Reteach expected behavior Practice expected behaviors □ |dentified/removed classroom distractors □ Redirection Established a behavioral cue/prompt (verbal/non-verbal) □ Student conference □ Seat change □ Tangible recognition □ Detention □ Parent contact □ Proximity to adult □ Loss of privilege □ Parent conference Extra assistance □ Self-monitoring □ Provide a structured choice □ Self-reflection/ essay □ Buddy classroom timeout □ Classroom suspension □ Modified assignments

Administrator provides teacher feedback and family is contacted.
