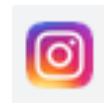

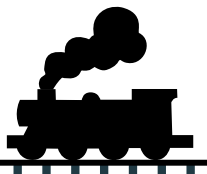

Back to School Night provides an opportunity to get more in-depth of the grade level curriculum, classroom expectations, goals for the year, and starting the year, "right on track."

HEALTH SAFETY

Here is a simple guide to help you decide when to keep your student home from school and when they can return based on recommendations from the American Academy of Pediatrics and the California Department of Public Health.

Fever

- Stay home if a fever is 100.4 F or higher.
- Return when fever has gone away without fever-reducing medication for a full night.

Diarrhea

- Stay home if your student's stool is likely to leak or if they are unlikely to make it to the toilet in time. If the stool looks bloody or black, seek medical attention.
- Return when improving.

Vomiting

- Stay home if vomiting has occurred two or more times in 24 hours.
- Return when vomiting has ended overnight, and your student can hold down liquids and food.

PARKING LOT PROCEDURES ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

- **VEHICLE** if you drop off or pick up from the traffic circle. Do NOT leave car unattended.
- **Pick up:** All students will be escorted to the front of the school. Only Preschool and Kindergarten parents are allowed to drop off and pick up their students.
- **Pick up:** Parents, please be aware that there is NO supervision at the park on the corner of Calle San Marcos and Olympic Blvd. The park may or may not be a safe place for students to "hang out" unsupervised after school.
- Do not walk across the traffic flow

DO NOT DROP OFF STUDENTS BEFORE THIS TIME

To keep our school safe, please follow all parking lot expectations and the directions of staff members.

Here is the traffic plan, please be kind and follow the instructions

- **Drop off & Pick up:** Traffic flow is in one direction only (counter clockwise) around the parking lot.
- **Drop off & Pickup:** Pull forward in the traffic circle (do not leave a big gap). STAY IN YOUR line or the entrance/exit of the parking lot. Only walk on sidewalks and crosswalks.
- Please, Only cross on Calle San Marcos at the crosswalks (no jaywalking). This is for your safety!
- Please do not park on the red lines and assigned staff parking spaces.

THERE IS NO LEFT TURN IN OR OUT OF THE PARKING LOT.



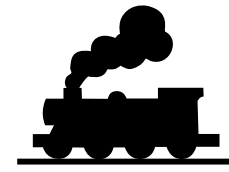
ABSENCES

HEALTH OFFICE

A health technician is on campus five days a week for 5.5 hours daily. The school nurse is on campus 2 days a week.

Students are not allowed to carry any type of medication with them during the school day.

A health technician cannot administer any medication without written and signed instructions from your medical professional.

Before administering medication, a signed medication request form for the current school year must be on file in the Health Office.

SCHOOL BREAKFAST & LUNCH INFO

Breakfast is available at 7:20 A.M. - 7:45 A.M.

Only students buying breakfast will be allowed in the cafeteria at this time. Each child in Grades K-6 must eat lunch daily and is responsible for bringing his/her lunch from home or picking up a meal from the school cafeteria. **Lunches may NOT be dropped off in the office.** The California Department of Education (CDE) has approved free meals for ALL students attending in person learning during the 23/24 school year. We encourage households not enrolled in the Community Eligibility Provision who participate in the Free or Reduced-Price Meal Program to re-apply for benefits for the 23/24 school year, regardless of the CDE's approval for free meals. This will ensure the continuation of free or reduced-price benefits if CDE lifts its approval for free meals.
