- Cell Phones
  - Virtually: Cell phones are expected to be put away for the entirety of the lesson unless otherwise instructed. Students who cannot adhere to this procedure will be exited from the lesson and will have to get the information at another time.
  - On Campus: Cell phones will be encouraged to be kept in designated charging station for the class period.
