## **Grade Points:**

A = 4 points

B = 3 points

C = 2 points

D = 1 point

F = 0

<u>Definiton</u>: A grade point average (G.P.A.) is a number that represents the average value of all of your grades.

**Question:** How do you calculate your G.P.A?

Answer: You add your grade points and divide that total by the number of classes (six) you have. See the example below...

**Important**: To be eligible to participate in school activities you need a G.P.A. of  $\underline{2.00}$  or higher.

To be on the honor roll you need a G.P.A. of <u>3.00</u> or higher.

Sara's G.P.A. is 3.16
