
2 Separate Learning Options

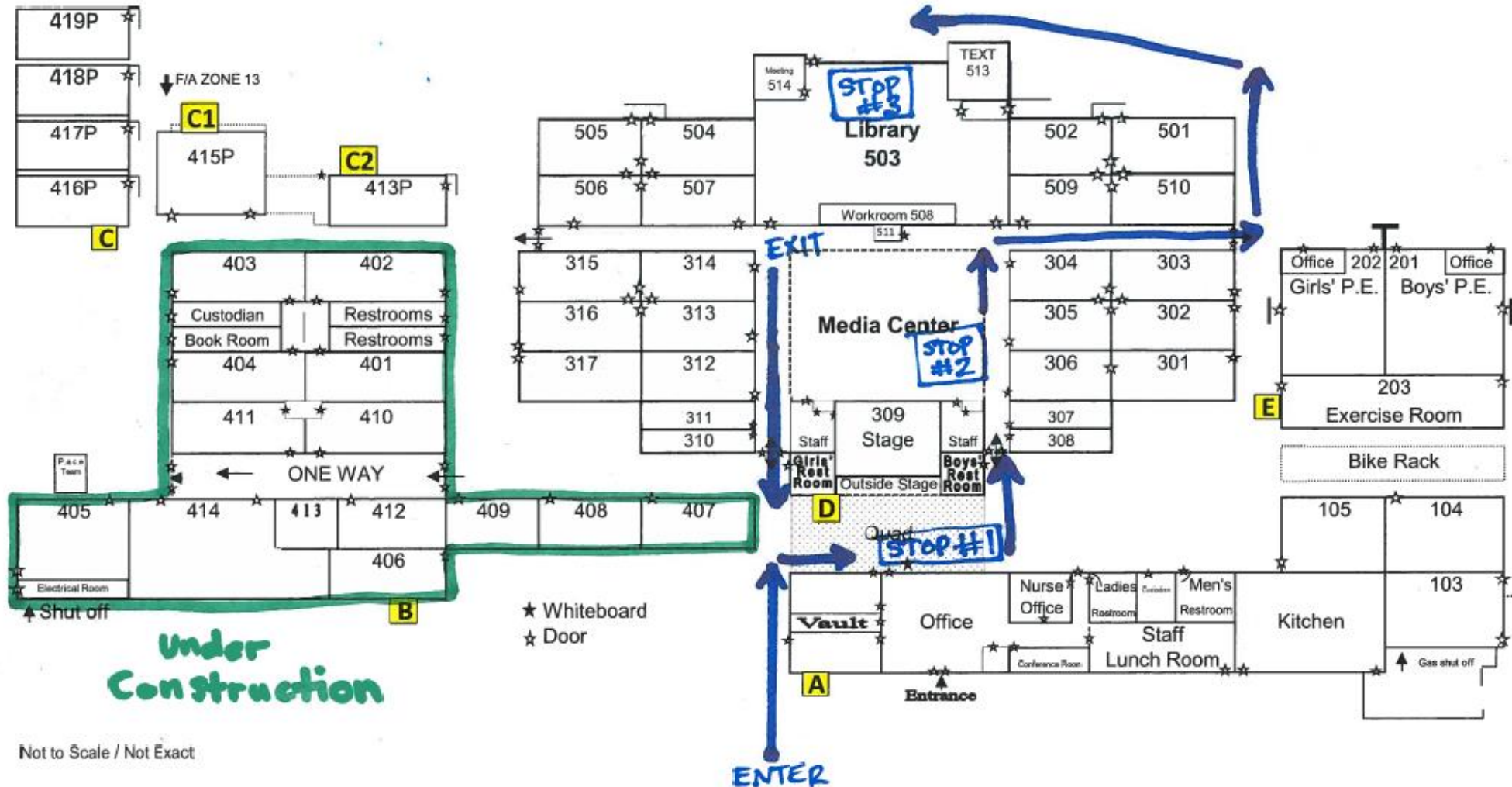
