Number Model: $88+92+73 = 253$

Answer: **253 t-shirts**

Answer: **66 potatoes**

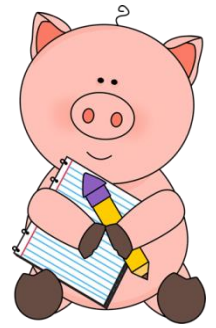
3. Katrina had \$40.00 to buy a birthday gift for her brother. She bought him a game that cost \$32.50. How much money does Katrina have left?
