

TO TARGET SOCIAL SKILLS OR QUESTION ASKING, YOU CAN HAVE THE PLAYER ASK ANOTHER PLAYER BEFORE COMPLETING HIS OR HER TURN. THE PLAYER WHO FINISHES THE BOX SHOULD PUT THEIR INITIALS IN THE BOX. WHEN ALL THE DOTS HAVE BEEN CONNECTED, THE PLAYER WITH THE MOST BOXES WINS!
