

## ***CVUSD Summer Enrichment Program 2024***

### FAQs

**1) Are there any costs associated with SEP enrollment?**

No, the program is offered at no cost to CVUSD students enrolled in the SEP.

**2) Does my student need to attend the full day (7 a.m. – 6 p.m.) of the program?**

No, the program will be available for students to attend from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. each day; however, students are not required to stay for the entirety of the program each day. The recommendation is that students attend at least half of the program day.

**3) Does my student need to attend every day of the SEP session?**

No; however, the recommendation is that your student attend the majority of the program session and are absent no more than five days out of the 15 program days per session.

**4) Will transportation be available for my student to attend the SEP?**

**5) My student will be enrolled in the CVUSD for the 24/25 school year; however, they are not a currently enrolled student with CVUSD. Can my student register for the SEP?**

The SEP is only available to currently enrolled CVUSD students in grades TK-6<sup>th</sup>.
