- _____ One or more processing deficits (A deficit is defined as a processing score that is both a normative and an intra-individual weakness)
- _____ At least one psychological/cognitive processing strength that is one of the following:
 - _____ A statistically significant intra-individual strength
 - _____ A normative strength (above average score 116 or above)
 - _____ A score within the average range (85-115)
- _____ The psychological/cognitive processing deficit subtest scores are unitary
- _____ The deficient area of achievement has a below average score (84 and below)
- _____ The deficient area of achievement subtest scores are unitary.
- _____ The deficient area of achievement is substantiated by both academic data such as grades, work samples, etc. and observations.
- _____ There is a research-based link between the deficient area of achievement and at least one related psychological/cognitive processing deficit. See Table 3 of Dehn's PPA Manual.
