In an effort to slow the community spread of COVID-19, Dr. Enfield, Superintendent, directed the closure of Chino Valley Unified School District ("District") Schools effective Monday, March 16, 2020, through Friday, May 1, 2020. The District has determined that it is necessary to close its schools to prevent/contain the spread of COVID-19, in consultation with the Center for Disease Control ("CDC"), the California Department of Education ("CDE"), the Department of Public Health ("DPH"), and other relevant information available to the District.

According to guidance from the United States Department of Education, if a district temporarily closes schools to prevent the spread of and/or contain COVID-19 and provides educational services/access to general education students, the district must ensure comparable educational services/access are provided to students with disabilities. The District extended Spring Break from March 16 - March 27, 2020, so no educational services/access for any student are being provided during that time.

Starting March 30, 2020, the District is providing Extended Learning Plans for all students, including students with disabilities. The Extended Learning Plans provide fundamental learning opportunities for each grade level and they can be accessed through the District's website at <https://www.chino.k12.ca.us/>. Resources for students with disabilities can be found on the Special Education Department's website at <https://www.chino.k12.ca.us/domain/730>.

Beginning on April 14, 2020, your child will participate in Distance Learning. For information about Distance Learning, please go to your child's teacher's webpage, which can be accessed through the school site webpage. If you have questions about your child's Distance Learning Classroom, be sure to contact your child's teacher. Contact information for all teaching staff including special education teachers is located on each individual teacher's classroom website listed under each school.

The District's special education related services providers have been tasked with creating a remote learning plan for students on their caseload to ensure that IEP goals and objectives are being implemented to the extent possible. Staff will be reaching out to you either by phone or e-mail.
