Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

During the Chino Valley Unified School District's School Board Meeting on February 23, 2021, the Board of Education voted to open school for students in Blended Learning. This decision, as well as the plan described below to provide educational services to your child, is based on guidance from the Center for Disease Control, the California Department of Education, the Department of Public Health, and other relevant information available to the District, including County and State orders.

You are receiving this letter because you have elected for your child to participate in Blended Learning and the Blended Learning Program will start in-person instruction as follows:

- a. March 4-5, 2021: Grades TK-2 at Standard Track Schools
- b. March 8, 2021: Grades 3-6 at Standard Track Schools
- c. Cal Aero Elementary Tracks
 - i. Track A: March 5
 - ii. Track B: March 8
 - iii. Track C: March 15
 - iv. Track D: April 5
- d. Secondary Schools: Begin in-person instruction for grades 7-12 when the County meets State Guidelines.

Your child will attend school in-person two days a week, participate in teacher lead on-line learning on minimum days, and receive asynchronous instruction for two days a week. For students with disabilities, the District will continue to implement the Individualized Education Program (IEP) to the extent feasible. Your child's special education teacher or service providers will contact you to provide you with an Individualized Learning Plan personalized for your child. The Individualized Learning Plan will outline how your child's IEP will be implemented through Blended Learning and may include accommodations to support your child's access to Blended Learning. School staff will be reaching out to you either by phone or e-mail to obtain your input. Contact information for your child's related services providers are posted on the Special Education Department's webpage at <https://www.chino.k23.ca.us>.

As students are returning to in-person learning two days a week, related services like speech & language and occupational therapy may be provided in-person during the school day or may continue on-line. The special education teachers and service providers will collaborate with you and memorialize any changes in the Individualized Learning Plan. If you have questions or would like to otherwise provide input regarding your child's educational program, or if you would like to meet in an IEP meeting to discuss the provision of a free, appropriate public education, please contact your child's case carrier. It is our desire to work in collaboration with you to ensure that students have access to a meaningful education under these unusual circumstances.
