Tardy/Discipline Policy

Grading

Summative Assessments (60%) - Tests, Quizzes, Projects, Essays Formative Assessments (40%) - Classwork, Homework, Participation

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Students will receive a 0% on any assignment if they are caught cheating or plagiarizing on an assignment, test, or paper. This includes using A.I. to complete an assignment.

Classroom Expectations

- ★ Students will check the Google Classroom daily.
- \star Students will not share their login information or passwords with others.
- \star Students will complete all assignments and turn them in on time.
- ★ Students will follow the school-wide expectations: responsible, respectful, and safe.
- ★ Students will follow academic honesty and not engage in plagiarism or cheating.
- \star Students will take notes to help them with assignments and assessments.

Technology Expectations

- ★ Students will have access to Google Classroom.
