Important dates:

- 3/8- Cohort A begins Monday/Thursday
- 3/10- Cohort B begins Wednesday/Friday

Information about Blended Learning: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- All kids will be in school two days a week according to their cohort schedule.
- Minimum Day: All kids will be at home online every Tuesday with a minimum day schedule dismissing about 10:30. (like now) Office hours will be 10:30-11:30.
- Asynchronous: All kids will have 4 hours of work to do on their asynchronous days- days not at school. This is **REQUIRED** because it is a school day. The asynchronous days are not holidays. In order to **NOT** be marked absent for the day, you **MUST** answer the question of the day that will be posted in Google Classwork no later than 3:00 p.m. The work that is assigned **MUST** be turned in no later than Friday by 3:00 p.m. It will not be new learning and will consist of review, reading, PE, projects, etc. Students will need to "Turn In" their asynchronous assignments in Google Classroom Classwork. If they choose not to turn it in, it may affect their scores. Students will not have the opportunity to ask questions during class on their asynchronous days because I will be teaching another group of kids every day. They can email me, and I will respond as soon as I can.
- Agenda: I will have everything on the Google Classroom Stream and Classwork every day according to your child's cohort. Please

refer to that daily, and look under your child's cohort as to what they need to complete for their asynchronous work and homework.

- Devices: I will post in the Google Classroom Stream if your child will need to bring their laptop to school. If they do, please make sure your child's laptop is charged.
- Supplies: Students CANNOT share supplies. Your child will need a set of supplies at school and at home. Please refer to the supply list in Google Classroom Stream to know what they should have at school.
- Textbooks: Kids will be taking their textbooks and folders back and forth to school since we can't share. However, I will put in the Google Classroom Stream daily what textbooks they will need for the days they are at the school.
- Masks: Kids need to wear a mask every day, all day. Having some spares in their backpack would be prudent.
- Recess/Lunch: Kids will only be allowed to play with our class during the day while practicing social distancing guidelines.
- P.E.: We will be taking breaks, however, will not be doing PE at school because we need the time for essential standards. (They will have recess and lunch) They need to do 100 minutes of PE a week and this will be done on their days at home. A log will be on Google Classroom for them to fill out each week.
- Library: We will have library time while in school. Please make sure they have a book to read. I have books in my classroom library they can borrow, but our school library will not be open. They can read from Epic online at home.
- We will be washing hands- A LOT!
- Water Bottles: Please bring a water bottle. They cannot drink out of the water fountains at school.
