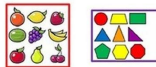
# Kindergarten ELA Goals

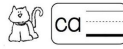

# Grading Policy

Report Cards will go home at the end of every trimester. The current grading policy is as follows. If a standard has not been completely and explicitly taught, there will be an X.

**4 Excelling** - Students at the Excelling level of performance are consistently performing at grade level, can demonstrate independence, and can extend the grade level standards, when applicable, expected at this point of the school year.

**3 Achieving** - Students at the Achieving level of performance demonstrate an adequate understanding of and ability to apply skills needed to meet grade level standards expected at this point of the school year.

**2 Progressing** - Students at the Progressing level of performance are partially meeting the grade level standards expected at this of the school year.

**1 Beginning/Standard Not Met** - Students at the Beginning/Standard Not Met are not yet meeting the grade level standards expected at this point of the school year.

**Stamp** - Your child will receive a stamp on their assignment if they completed the work independently, in a neat and timely manner.

**AM Schedule:** 8:00 to 11:30 M, T, W, Th, F

**Arrival:** Students will be dropped off at the kindergarten gate. You must wait until a teacher opens the gate. Do NOT leave your child unattended.

You MUST park your car in the parking lot or on the street if permitted. Wait at the kindergarten gate by the playground and we will open when it is okay for students to enter.

**Dismissal:** Students will be dismissed from the classrooms.

You MUST park your car in the parking lot or on the street if permitted. Wait at the kindergarten gate by the playground and we will open when it is okay for you to enter.





# Snack, Recess & Restroom

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Snack: Send your child with ONE healthy snack and water. We have been reminded by admin that this is a snack, not lunch. Send something they can open and eat quickly.

**\*Do NOT send: juice, milk, jell-o, pudding, fruit cups or drinkable yogurts/go-gurts or sticky/sugary foods. It will be sent back home.**

Recess: Students will have 10 minutes to eat their snack and 10 minutes to play on the playground.

Restroom: Students have access to classroom bathrooms they are permitted to use when explicit and direct instruction is not taking place. They are also encouraged to use the restroom during recess. Please have your child use the restroom before school as well.



# Attendance Policy



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Absences are to be reported to the office. Please call (909) 606-8531. We also appreciate a text from you on the Parent Square app to let us know that your child will be absent.

Makeup work is not typically required. We will do our best to save classwork and send it home when your child returns to school.

If your child will be absent more than 5 days in a row, you must contact the office several weeks in advance to arrange Independent Study.

Your teacher will be sending a sign-up link.



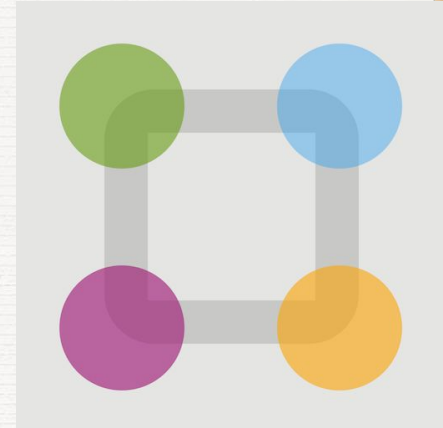

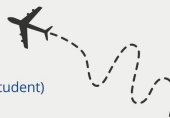
