


Classroom Website vs.





Assignments



- Homework
 - Daily homework will consist of a daily math page, practice math facts, practice spelling words, and read for 20 minutes
- Tests
 - Spelling Tests given weekly on Fridays
 - Grammar Tests given on Fridays after each week in Wonders (ELA program)
 - Reading comprehension Tests given on Fridays after each week in Wonders
 - Math Tests given at the end of each topic
 - Social Studies Tests given at the end of each unit
 - Science Tests given at the end of each module
- Special Assignments
 - Special assignments such as poems, projects, and holiday themed assignments will be assigned through Google Classroom

Minute Math

- Practiced daily in class
- Students are timed for one minute as they complete a set of addition or subtraction problems.
- Students start on +2s.
- When students complete all of the problems correctly within the minute they "pass" and move on to the next number.
- The goal is to finish the subtraction tests by the end of the year.
