




- Please check Google Classroom every Monday for Homework and for homework questions.

Blue Test Folder




- Sent home every few weeks with student's tests



Assignments



Homework

 Daily homework will consist of a daily math page, practice math facts, practice spelling words, and read for 20 minutes

Tests

- Spelling Tests given weekly on Fridays
- Grammar Tests given on Fridays after each week in Wonders (ELA program)
- Reading comprehension Tests given on Fridays after each week in Wonders
- Math Tests given at the end of each topic
- Social Studies Tests given at the end of each unit
- Science Tests given at the end of each module

Special Assignments

 Special assignments such as poems, projects, and holiday themed assignments will be assigned through Google Classroom

Minute Math

- Practiced daily in class
- Students are timed for one minute as they complete a set of addition or subtraction problems.
- Helps students with their math facts knowledge and fluency
- Students start on +2s.
- When students complete all of the problems correctly within the minute they "pass" and move on to the next number.
- When students complete all of the addition minute math/subtraction minute math they will take the "big test" (100 problems in 5 minutes)
- The goal is to finish the subtraction tests by the end of the year.

DEVICE PROTECTION PLAN

Protest your device

The District Plan covers accidental damage to student Chromebooks or Windows laptops and is designed to limit a CVUSD family's financial liability for any damages as described below.

COVERAGE

Accidental Damage: Pays for accidental damage caused by liquid spills, drops, or any other unintentional event.

Theft: Pays for loss due to theft; the claim requires a filed police report.

Fire: Pays for damage due to fire; the claim requires a filed police report.

Device will be repaired or replaced: At the discretion of the Chino Valley Unified School District, the student's device will be repaired or replaced.

PROGRAM FEE/COVERAGE OPTIONS OFFERED/PAYMENTS

Device Protection Plan:

- · Non-refundable fee: \$40 for the current school year.
- Coverage: Repair/Replacement of school issued device throughout the current school year.
 Coverage is per student.

Per Incident Fee:

- \$50 fee per incident. Paid at each incident.
- · Coverage: Repair/Replacement of school issued device for each incident.

 Payments can be submitted by cash or check at your student's school site or electronically by visiting <u>www.myschoolbucks.com</u>.

EFFECTIVE COVERAGE/EXPIRATION DATES

Effective Date: Based on the receipt of payment and the completed Device Protection Plan agreement. The process must be initiated at the beginning of the current school year or during the enrollment period of July 1, 2024, through August 31, 2024. It cannot be applied retroactively. **Expiration Date:** Last day of applicable school year.

Reporting: Student must report issues to the designated staff member in a timely manner.



EXCLUSIONS

Intentional Damage: The student will be responsible for the full amount of the repair/replacement for intentional acts to the student's device or the device of any other student. This includes throwing, kicking, or other purposeful acts.

Cosmetic: CVUSD *will not* replace a device for purely cosmetic issues that do not affect the functionality of the device.

Misuse: "Jailbreaking" or otherwise voiding the warranty by altering the device.


