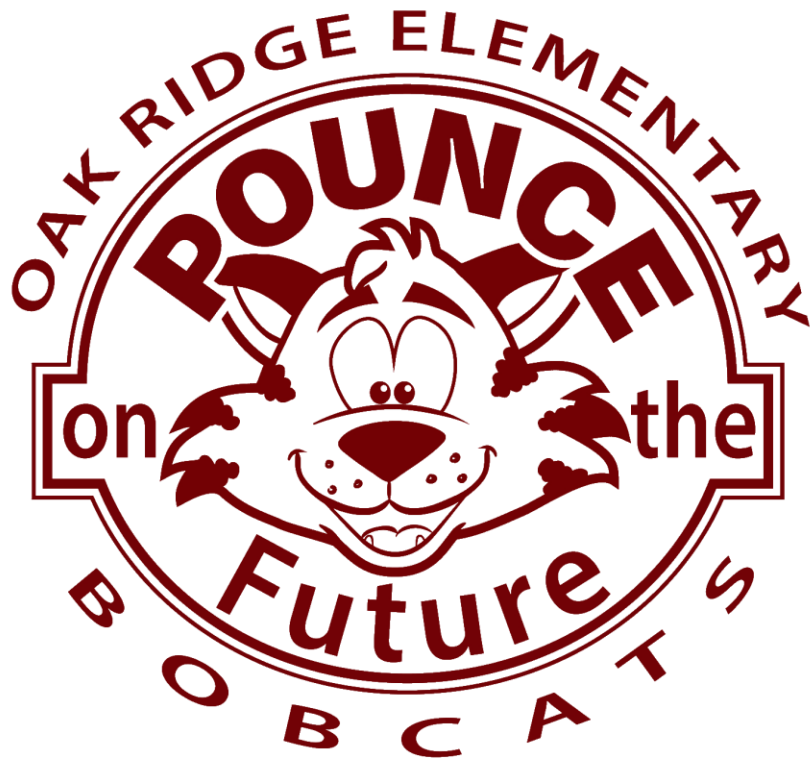
Vision Statement:

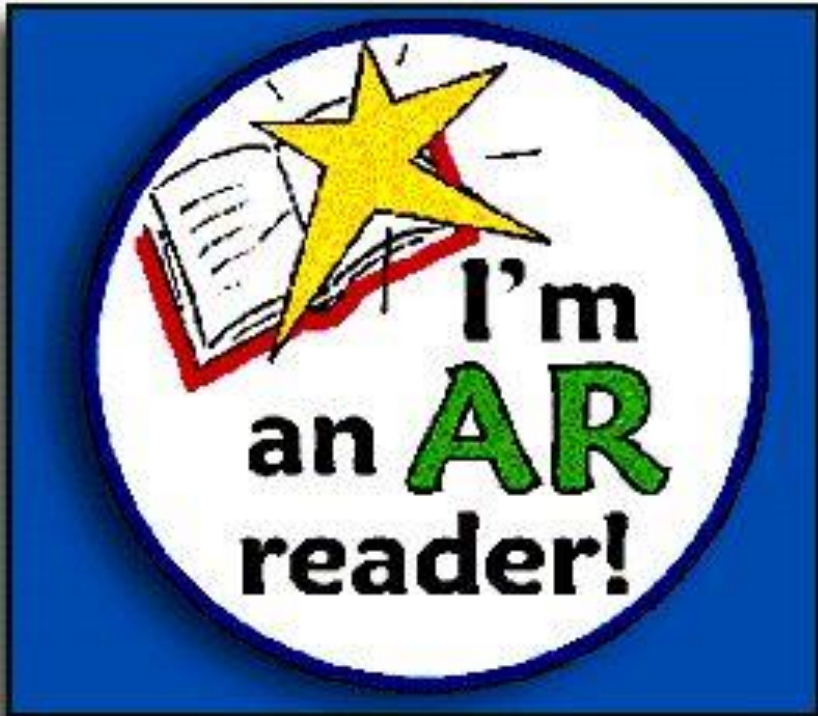


**Oak Ridge is proud to maintain an average of

Homework Expectations



Your child will receive their homework on Monday and it will be due back on Friday. No need to complete it all in one day.



Students will be given 20 minutes at the end of each school day to work on their homework. (Vocabulary, Spelling, Math, Reading)



Spelling Tests will be given on Fridays.



Students need to read for 20 minutes daily and complete their reading log.

Behavior System

- Students are given daily opportunities to earn class money for following classroom expectations.
- Example: Participation, staying on task, behavior, being responsible, being prepared, completing assignments, giving great effort.
- They can also lose money by not following directions, being off task, being disrespectful, not being responsible.
- They can use their money earned during our Fun Friday. To purchase rewards such as a pick a seat pass, technology pass, show and tell, lunch with the teacher, homework pass, treasure box and snacks.
