


### Cal Aero's Daily Schedule

#### Grades

- Grades in Junior High are very important and are made up from HOMEWORK and Test/Project scores.
- You will be transferring from rubric grades to letter grades.
- Mrs. Gonzales will show students the new grading system during the first few weeks of school and how to calculate a GPA (Grade Point Average) PLUS, help each student set learning goals by subject
- The School District sets a minimum 2.0 GPA requirement to participate in sports, attend dances, or promote from 8<sup>th</sup> grade.

- ★ It is extremely important that students and parents monitor academic progress regularly in Jr. High using the Aeries Portal to check progress throughout each Trimester on a weekly or even daily basis.


## First Day of School – Aug. 5th

- ★ Complete data confirmation! You can then see your class schedule BEFORE school starts on Friday Aug. 2nd if data confirmation is complete.
- ★ School starts at 8:00 am, so when the first bell rings at 7:56, head to your first period class to arrive on time. Students will receive a paper copy of class schedule during 1<sup>st</sup> period.
- ★ If a student doesn't know their first period there will staff members to assist them before school.
- ★ If you need help ask a leadership student who will be wearing hawaiian leis so you can easily identify them throughout the day.
- ★ Dismissal at 11:30 am (regularly 2:40 pm)

In the morning enter campus through the back gates.

Wait on black top area closest to the D building.

When bell rings at 7:56 am proceed to 1<sup>st</sup> period class to arrive and be seated by 8 am.



#### Campus Routines:

#### **Nutrition Break**



- $\star$  After 2nd period there is a 10 minute nutrition break.
- ★ Nutrition Break will be held at the Lunch Tables for both 7th & 8th. You will be seated during this time not walking around.
- ★ Use this time to eat a healthy snack at the Lunch Tables and drink water, then use the restroom and socialize with friends outside. This is not "recess" the blacktop area is off limits.

## Campus Routines:

# Lunch is between 4 <sup>th</sup> and 5 <sup>th</sup> periods and students do not take their backpacks with them to lunch. They are dropped off in 5 period classes before going to eat.

# If buying lunch, line up by the cafeteria door. You need to memorize your student ID to enter when you get your lunch. Until you have it memorized bring it written on a paper with you.

#### Lunch

No food or drink consumption away from tables (except for water)

Playground structure is off limits

Students may use the: ball walls, basketball courts, tetherball, and field areas

If you wish to attend a club meeting or see a teacher only use the gates nearest the library.

Any area between buildings B & C is <u>off</u> limits as are the B and C building Bathrooms

When lunch is over and the bell rings students walk directly to their 5 th period class

# Campus Routines: Dismissal



- Exit campus through front push gate by the D Building. Junior high students should should not exit on the South side of campus.
- If riding a bike, skateboard or scooter: you must walk off campus before using them. You must also have a helmet or you will be cited by the police.
- Wait for your ride on the school sidewalk or if walking, walk home immediately.
- Do not "hang out" at the park attached to the school as the City uses it during after-school hours.
- Until you reach your home, you are still subject to school disciplinary consequences (i.e. suspension).
- If you are waiting for a younger sibling wait just outside the gates at a prearranged spot. If picking up sibling on South side you must walk around the school to the South side.

#### Campus Routines: Behavior

Time Sensitive: Required 6th Grade Student Vaccinations Prior to 7th Grade for 2023/24 School Year!

Attention NEW 7th Grade Parents.

All students entering 7th grade need to have a "Whooping Cough" (Tdap/Pertussis) and Varicella 1 and 2 vaccine booster. You will need to provide to the school office a stamped California Immunization Record (yellow) card as proof of the Tdap booster vaccine (Adacel or Boostrix).

California has enacted law (AB 354) which requires public and private school students to be immunized against whooping cough as follows:

- Students entering 7th grade need to show proof of a Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) and Varicella 1 and 2 booster shot before starting school.
- 7th Grade students will not be able to attend school or receive a class schedule without showing proof of the Tdap/Pertussis booster vaccine and Varicella 1 and 2.
- · This requirement can be met by receiving one dose of Tdap vaccine on or after the 7th birthday.


