Biblical Allusions

- 1. Adam's rib: Genesis 2:21-22; God though that Adam needed a helper and helper and he took one of Adam's rib and made woman.
- 2. Alpha and Omega: Revelations 1:7-8, 11; This is Gods message to John and to the churches. God states that he is the first and last and everlasting.
- 3. Am I my brother's keeper?: Genesis 4:9; Adam and Eve had two children Cain and Abel. Abel was keeper of sheep were Cain took farmed. Cain grew envious of Abel because God likes Abel's offering more then Cain's. Cain talked with Abel and killed him.
- 4. Ark of Covenant: Genesis 8:20; God made a covenant with Noah that he would not destroy the earth with a flood.
- 5. Ashes to ashes, dust to dust: Genesis 3: 17-19; Because Adam and Eve ate the forbidden fruit he will have to work for his food and will die.
- 6. Babel: Genesis 11:8-9; After the flood man build cities and spoken the same language, however God came and scattered the people abroad and made different languages and thus the tower people were building came to call Babel.
- 7. Be fruitful and multiply: Genesis 1:22; after God made the animals he command them to be fruitful and multiply
- 8. Bitter as a wormwood

- 10. Burning bush: Exodus 3:1-2 God send one of his angel to speak to Moses and to led the people from slavery. There was a bush that was on fire, but did not burn.
- 11. By their fruits shall ye know them: Matthew 7:20; It said that be careful of the false prophase and know them by their message.
- 12. Camel through the eye of a needle: Matthew 19:23-24; it is saying that it is very hard for a rich man to go to heaven and that people should give their goods to the church and God.
- 13. Cast the first stone: John 8:47; Jesus ask the people to condemn the adulterous lady if they are without sin. Thus people should not condemn others, but forgive other's sins.
- 14. Crown of thorns: Matthew 27:27-29; When Jesus is led to be crucified the Romans nailed him on a cross and place a crown of thorns on his head.

- 15. David and Goliath: 1samual 17:4, 8-9; Goliath who is a very strong brute challenge people and David who is not at all big accepted. David using wit defeated Goliath
- 16. Daniel in the lion's den: Daniel 6:16; Daniel was toward into the lion's den because he didn't follow one law, however God save him and though out the night he was not hurt by the lions.
- 17. Doubting Thomas: John 20:24-29 Thomas would not believe that Jesus was back from the dead, however Jesus show him self to Thomas and thus Thomas believed.
- 18. Eye for eye, tooth for tooth: Exodus 21:23-24; If someone did something bad to you and had done so before then revenge should be taken and of the same degree.
- 19. Forty days and forty nights: Genesis 7:4; when Noah build the ark God made it rain for Forty days and forty nights and flooded the earth.
- 20. Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse
- 21. Gain the whole world but lose your own soul: Matthew 16:24-26; Jesus is about to be crucified and he said that men who helps him will be save and those that didn't will not be.
- 22. Gold, frankincense, and myrrh: Matthews 2:11; the three wise men bought gold, frankincense and myrrh at the birth of Jesus.
- 23. Golden calf: Exodus 32:4 The Israel out of Egypt but on the foot of the mountain Sinai the people grew scared that Moses would not back from the mountain. They put all their gold and made a calf to worship.
- 24. Golden rule: Matthew 7:12-14l; The rule said by Jesus do things to other people as you would want them to do to you.
- 25. Good Samaritan: Luke 10:30-37; A man was beaten up by robbers and left for dead and a Samaritan came along and tend to his wounds, gave him food and place him in a hotel.
- 26. Harden your heart: exodus 4:21; God commands Moses to ask the Pharaoh to let the Israelis go, but God will harden the Pharaoh's heart and the Pharaoh will not let hem go.
- 27. Jonah and the whale: Jonah 23:14; Jonah was a reluctant messenger and would not do as God command. However when he try to run away he was in a storm and was throw into the sea were a whale commanded by God saved him.

- 28. Lamb to the slaughter: Isaiah 53: 6-7; the people is compared to sheep and because they have gone away from God they will die.
- 29. Let my people go: Exodus 4:21, 5:1; Moses asked the Pharaoh to let the people of Israel go free.
- 30. Loaves and fishes: Matthew 14:15-17; Jesus had many people with him and didn't have enough food however he prayed to God and he had enough to feed all the people and there were stilled leftovers.
- 31. Manna from heaven: Exodus:16:14-15; Moses led the people to free land and God gave them a small round thing that was to be their bread.
- 32. Mark of Cain: Genesis 4:15; After Cain killed his brother God place on him a mark on him and whoever find him will kill him.
- 33. Methuselah: Genesis 5:25-27; He was the son of Enoch and part of Adam's family. He was also the grand father of Noah.
- 34. Noah's ark: Genesis 6:1-9:17; God is sick of all of man's wickedness and decided to flood the earth for fourth days and fourth nights. He commanded Noah to bring pairs of animal and his family on an ark and they will be the new race.
- 35. Parting of the waters: Exodus 14:15-16; When Moses led the people out of Egypt the Pharaoh regretted his decision and send his soldiers to retrieve them. Moses parted the water of the Red Sea and allow his people to pass, however when all of his people passed the water went back and drowned the soldiers.
- 36. Peals before swine: Matthew 6:7; Do not put what is precious before something that will surly destroy it.
- 37. Prodigal son: Luke 15:11-14; A son who spend all his money come back and ask his father for forgiveness and the father forgave him.
- 38. Sackcloth and ashes: Matthew 11:20-21; Jesus warns cities where people didn't believe that all of its riches will be reduce to nothing.
- 39. Seven pillars of Wisdom: Proverbs 9:1; God tell the seven way of Wisdom.
- 40. Sodom and Gomorrah: Genesis 18:20-21; The two cities has great sin so God destroyed the cities.
- 41. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof: Matthew 6:34; Worry about one day at a time and let the next day work itself out.

- 42. Thirty pieces of silver: Matthew 26:14-16; Jodas betrayed Jesus for thirty pieces of silver.
- 43. This is my body: Matthew 26: 26-29; Jesus took the bread at the Last Supper and said "this is my body".
- 44. Tree of Knowledge: Genesis 2:9, 16-17; Man was forbidden to eat the fruit of the tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil, but he did and that was the original sin.
- 45. Turn the other cheek: Luke 6:29; If a person hit you turn the other cheek and allow them to hit you on the other as well.
- 46. Voice crying in the wilderness: Isaiah 40:1-3; God say to people should cry to God and go to him.
- 47. Water into wine: John 2:7-10; Jesus took water and turn it into wine in a wedding, and that was his first miracle.
- 48. Way of all flesh

- 50. Who lives by the sword shall die by the sword: Matthew 26:49-54; People who harm others will in turn be harm as well
- 51. Wisdom of Solomon: Kings 3:16-28; Solomon asked God for wisdom. He used it when two women disputed which was the mother of a child. He said to divide the child in half and give each to one woman. One woman says yes and other no. Solomon gave the child to the women that said no.
