Behavior

We are Responsible, Respectful, and Safe!!

•In the classroom, the clip chart is used for students to clip up and clip down for unwanted behaviors.

•When students clip up, they will receive a raffle ticket for a classroom drawing.

•If a student clips down to teacher's choice, either a note will be sent home, or they will sit out recess.

School-wide Behavior Expectations

- If a student is not following school-wide expectations, they will be warned. After a warning students can lose recess or if the behavior continues, they can receive an incident log. This log will note the infraction and will be sent home for the parent to sign.
- If a students receives 3 incident logs, on the 4th incident, they will receive a Minor Offense Referral and be sent to the office to speak with an administrator.

School-wide Behavior Expectations

Positive

- When a student is following our school expectations, they may be given an Aim High ticket. An Aim High ticket can be distributed by any adult.
- Students may redeem their Aim High tickets at the Aim High store on Thursday during lunch.
- They are always looking for volunteers to help run the store.



- All grades are a combination of classwork, tests, class participation, homework, and teacher observation.
- Our school adopted the Twig Science Curriculum. This new curriculum is very hands and on not as much paper/pencil.
- We will not be having spelling tests. Spelling is practiced in the classroom and within their writing.

Classwork
