- Welcome & Introductions- Dr. Finkbiner started the meeting at 9am with welcome and introductions.
- Activity- Dr. Finkbiner asked parents to share something about their students that makes them proud.
- Attendance- Participants were reminded to sign in.
- Dr. Finkbiner confirmed with DELAC that they have completed all of the required responsibilities.
- Annual Multilingual Recognition- Dr. Finkbiner announced this year's recipients of the Multilingual Recognition Awards Ceremony.
- Supporting Students Over the Summer- ELD coaches, Norma Mendoza and Rebecca Peterson, shared ways parents can help their students over the summer. Brochures were provided.
- EL Master Plan Updates for 2025-2026- Dr. Carrizosa shared that the Multilingual Master Plan will be updated and presented to the board for approval. We will include documents approved by DELAC this year. Dr. Carrizosa reviewed reclassification criteria and reminded participants to start checking for ELPAC scores in the Parent Portal towards the end of May. Dr. Carrizosa also reviewed the OPTEL form and reclassification form for students with IEPs.
- Survey Results- Dr. Finkbiner gave an update on the LCAP (Local Control Accountability Plan) and sought DELAC's feedback. He invited DELAC members to the next LCAP meeting on next Tuesday April 23rd 9:00 – 11:00 AM.
- Consolidated Application for Funding- Dr. Finkbiner explained the Consolidated Application for Funding. He asked for a volunteer to represent DELAC and sign verification that DELAC was informed about it. Victoria Romero from Dickson volunteered.
- Closing Activity – Participants reflected on what they learned through DELAC, what they want more training on and what they recommend for next year's DELAC. The meeting concluded at 11am.
