How will assignments be posted for the week for students?


I will create a **Weekly Lesson Plan** for students that will be posted by Monday morning of each week in *Google Classroom*.

We will be using Google Classroom as our online platform during Distance Learning 2.0.

How/when will students submit their work?

Students will submit their work on curriculum websites (Savvas EasyBridge & Wonders) and any other work outside these sites will be assigned and submitted through *Google Classroom*. The state of California requires 100 minutes per week of exercise. There will be a google form for PE to fill out weekly to verify that these minutes are being met. All student work for the week is to be completed and submitted by Friday at 11:00pm. All dates will be made very clear on our classroom Weekly Lesson Plans.

Assessments

When are assessments?

Assessments will take place throughout the week. These will be included in the **Weekly Lesson Plan** that students get access to at the beginning of each week via Google Classroom. If a particular assessment must be completed prior to the end of the week, the weekly plan will specifically note this. Assessments will take place on **Savvas EasyBridge and Wonders**.

Grades/Feedback

How will grades/feedback/current progress be communicated to students and parents?

Wonders and Savvas EasyBridge will provide instant feedback on assignments and assessments, if applicable. Work completed and submitted via **Google Classroom** will be assessed by the teacher and the teacher will leave comments and scoring information as needed. Parents will be encouraged to sign on to their student's ClassLink accounts to view assessment results (Savvas EasyBridge and Wonders). Teachers will also be emailing individually to communicate with parents if needed regarding student progress. Progress reports will be sent out halfway through the trimester, followed by a report card at the end of each trimester.
