DRIVER TRAINING TEACHER

DESCRIPTION OF POSITION:

Provides instruction to secondary school pupils in the safe and proper operation of motor vehicles using behind-the-wheel instruction and observation techniques.

MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Teaches pupils the manipulative and perceptive skills required for the safe and proper operation of a motor vehicle.

Attempts to develop in pupils the habit patterns which promote safe and proper motor vehicle operation.

Attempts to instill defensive driving attitudes and behavior in pupils which are conductive to the safe and proper operation of a motor vehicle.

Conducts laboratory instruction in motor vehicle operation by providing students with the opportunity to apply natural and manmade laws to actual driving situations.

Instructs pupils in how to cope with typical emergencies that are associated with operation of a motor vehicle.

Reinforces subject matter and skills taught in Driver Education courses.

Provides instruction in passenger and pedestrian conduct and safety.

Assists pupils in preparing applications and forms for obtaining student driver licenses. Issues certificates of completion to students who complete the course.

Confers with parents and students on the scheduling of driver training instruction sessions.

Keeps necessary records and prepares reports as required.

Develops weekly lesson plans and supplementary materials compatible with the basic instructional philosophy and curriculum of the District.

Provides students with the opportunity to partake in daily patriotic observance. Education Code 52720.

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Monitors classroom environment to ensure clean and safe conditions exist, notifying principal of any unclean or unsafe classroom conditions.

Monitors classroom activities making students responsible for putting materials, supplies, tools, etc., safely and neatly away at the end of class session.

CREDENTIAL: Special Secondary in Public Safety.

EDUCATION: Bachelor's Degree with major or minor in designated subject matter

including all courses needed to meet credential requirements.

SUPERVISION: Responsible to: School principal with coordination as assigned to

Department Chairman.

Responsible for: Students participating in driver training program.
