HSA Officer Board

*no campaigning allowed in HSA elections, no shirts, food, or "vote for ____" social media posts/fliers, voting is only based on your speech

President: create meeting agendas, oversee all events, orchestrate all remind messages as well as demand other officers to fulfill their roles, responsible for reaching out to guest speakers, planning HSA events, and field trips, in constant communication with administration

- requirements: must have been on officer board for at least a year, upperclassmen
- voting: all classes
- Vice President is whoever comes in second in the election for president

Activities Director: finds additional events for HSA, reaching out to people for speakers etc, make sure all HSA events are going as planned,

- voting: all classes

Class Ambassadors (One for each grade level): responsible for signing the hours of your class to verify them, track your classes participation in events and who volunteers for what in cases such as the Blood Drive, relay messages through the remind

- requirement: must be in the class you want to run for

- voting: only your class (ex: class of 2023 only votes for 2023 ambassador)

Treasurer: Responsible for Snap Raise fundraiser and planning other HSA fundraisers (contacting Chipotle, ShareTea, etc.), keeping track of the HSA budget and how much money to spend for an event

- voting: all classes

Secretary: responsible for making sure all senior hours are locked, keeps track of HSA meeting times/dates and records the agenda, ensures meeting attendance and hours in general

- voting: all classes

Publicist/ Digital Media Lead: post on the HSA Instagram continuously, make fliers/ social media posts, bring hype to HSA events, if needed create PPTs or Videos for HSA

- voting: all classes

HSA Officers: if the HSA Board feels a person who ran and lost should be on the board, they may choose a select amount of people to be on the board as a general at large officer
