## Purpose:

- 3. Must have a cumulative High School GPA of 3.0 or higher (Please submit current transcripts).
- 4. 2 Letters of Recommendation (1 from a teacher, counselor, coach, or employer and 1 from applicant's choice).
- 5. Secondary Education Plan (see application).
- 6. Must be willing to come to Howard Cattle's 6th grade promotion on May 21<sup>st</sup>, time TBD, to give a short speech during the ceremony.
- 7. Essay: Explain in a two-to-three-page essay what career and life goals you hope your educational advancement may assist you in. Explain how your years as a Howard Cattle Rustler affected your overall academic career and goals. ALL ESSAYS MUST BE TYPED.

ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS LISTED ABOVE MUST BE INCLUDED IN THE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PACKET FOR THE APPLICANT TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP. Completed applications are due to Chino High's College & Career Center by April 25, 2025.

The Howard Cattle Memorial Scholarship honors a gentleman who gave

generously to the Community in time and energy for over 50 years.

Howard Cattle's family moved to Chino in 1920. They originally lived in the back of the Opera House, where the Chino City Hall now stands. Howard graduated from Chino High School in 1924. He opened Chino Cleaners in 1933 and Howard's Men Store in 1938. Beginning in 1954 Howard's Men Store presented a Chino High Cowboy jacket to the outstanding varsity and B-weight players of each football game. Howard was appointed to the Chino City Council in 1954. He ran for election in 1957. He was appointed Mayor by the Council Members that same year. Howard's Men Store and Chino Cleaners were sold in 1965, ending one era so he could begin another.

During the years, Howard received awards, plaques and certificates from the following: Letter of Recognition, Boys Republic 1958; Certificate of Service, Chino Valley Advancement Association 1960; Grand Marshall, Chino Ranch Ride 1960; 20 — 30 Club Plaque as Honorary Member 1960; Chino Quarter Back Club Plaque 1961; National Little League Certificate 1962; Outstanding Citizen of the Year Award 1963; Honorary Service Award, Chino Unified School District Parent Council 1963; Dedicated Chino High Yearbook to Howard Cattle 1964; Howard Cattle Elementary School was named in his honor in 1988.
