#### **Purpose:**

#### **Application Criteria:**

Completed Joe Murillo Scholarship Application form.
Chino High School Senior accepted to a four-year, university at which they must plan on attending. ( <i>Please submit verification of acceptance</i> .)
Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher (Please submit current transcripts.)
History of participation in extracurricular activities such as team or individual sports.
One letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, or coach.
Essay: Explain in a short, two to three page essay how you hope your university education will aid you in exploring yourself and the world in which you live so that you can make a positive difference

Note: Letters of recommendation and essays must demonstrate how the applicant embodies the qualities noted in the purpose of this scholarship. Essays and Resumes must demonstrate the ability to write and communicate at a college level. Essays must be typed, double spaced, with one inch margins, and size 12 font. In addition to the content of the resume and essay, proper grammar, syntax, punctuation, and essay/resume format are expected of all applicants.

All documents required in the application criteria above MUST be included in the scholarship application packet for the applicant to be considered for the scholarship. *Incomplete and/or poorly written applications will not be reviewed or considered.* 

All application materials are due to the Chino High School Career Center by April 22, 2025.
