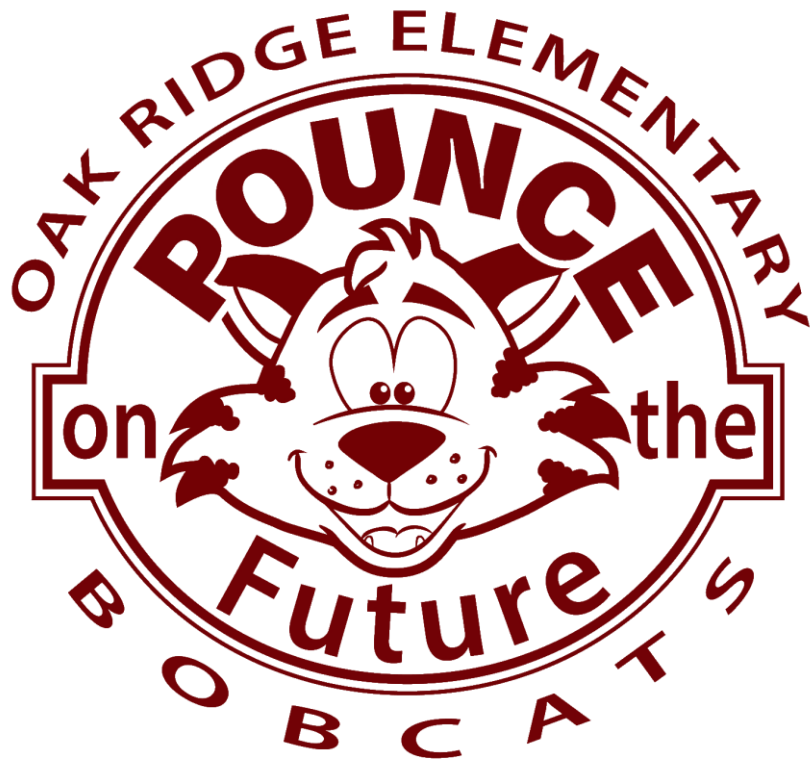
Vision Statement:

DRESS CODE

AR 5132-CVUSD Board Policies & Oak Ridge Parent Handbook - Specific Minimum Dress and Groom Standards for Grades K-6

- **Shoes** must be worn at all times. **Sandals must have heel straps.** Thongs, thong- type, or backless shoes or sandals are not permitted. Platform shoes above 2 inches are not permitted. Roller shoes are not permitted.
- **Clothes** shall be sufficient to **conceal undergarments at all times.** See-through or fish-net fabrics, halter tops, off-the-shoulder or low-cut tops, **bare midriffs**, and skirts or shorts that show the buttocks are prohibited.
 - Strapless tops are not permitted. Tank top straps must be two finger width and cover undergarments.
- **Hats**, caps and other head coverings **shall not be worn indoors** unless they are worn for religious or medical reasons.
 - Bill of hat must be worn over face
- Clothing, jewelry and personal items (backpacks, fanny packs, gym bags, water bottles etc.) shall be free of writing, pictures or any other insignia which are crude, vulgar, profane or sexually suggestive, which bear drug, alcohol or tobacco company advertising, promotions and likenesses, or which advocate racial, ethnic or religious prejudice.
- **Make-up** is **not permitted.**
- Clothes and belts must be the appropriate size and length when worn.
- Hair shall be clean and neatly groomed. Colored hair (such as blue, orange, green, etc.) is not permitted.

Students are expected to be at school. Each day of school should provide an important learning experience, and if your child(ren) are not here, they miss the learning continuity.

Board Policy requires a parent verification of each absence within 5 school days of the student's return to school. On the sixth day, the absence becomes unverified and cannot be changed. State law requires that each absence be cleared.

ATTENDANCE TERMS

Truant

Absent from school without a valid excuse three full days, or tardy or absent for more than any 30-minute period during the school day without a valid excuse on three occasions in one school year, or any combination thereof

LETTERS SENT FROM STUDENT INFORMATION SYSTEM

Habitual Truant

Truant on three or more occasions in a school year, provided that a site administrator has made a conscientious effort to hold at least one conference with a parent or guardian and the student, after sending notice

Chronic Truant

Absent from school without a valid excuse for ten percent or more of the school days in one school year, from the date of enrollment to the current date

TRUANCY VS. CHRONIC ABSENCE

TRUANCY

Counts only unexcused absences

- Emphasizes compliance with school rules

- Relies on legal and administrative solutions

VS.

CHRONIC ABSENCE

Counts all absences: excused, unexcused, and suspensions

- Emphasizes academic impact of missed days

- Uses community-based, positive strategies



TRUANCY LETTER PROCESS

Truancy Letter One (1)

Send after

- three (3) unexcused/unverified absences or
- three (3) period absences or
- three (3) thirty-minute tardies that occur or any combination thereof

6

Truancy Letter Two (2)

Send after


- six (6) unexcused/unverified absences or
- six (6) period absences or
- six (6) thirty-minute tardies that occur or any combination thereof

9

Truancy Letter Three (3)

Send after

- nine (9) unexcused/unverified absences or
- nine (9) period absences or
- nine (9) thirty-minute tardies that occur or any combination thereof



After Truancy Letter Two (2) is sent, the school must hold a **SART** meeting

AR 5113.1- Absent for 10 percent of school days (chronic truancy)

- The site administrator shall ensure that the student's parents/guardians are offered language-accessible support services to address the student's truancy
- SART Composition (Combination based on need):
 - Administrator
 - Attendance Liaison
 - School Counselor
 - School Psychologist
 - Student and/or Parent
 - Teacher
- At SART Meeting:
 - Develop a corrective action plan with parental input
 - Student will, again, be directed to attend all classes

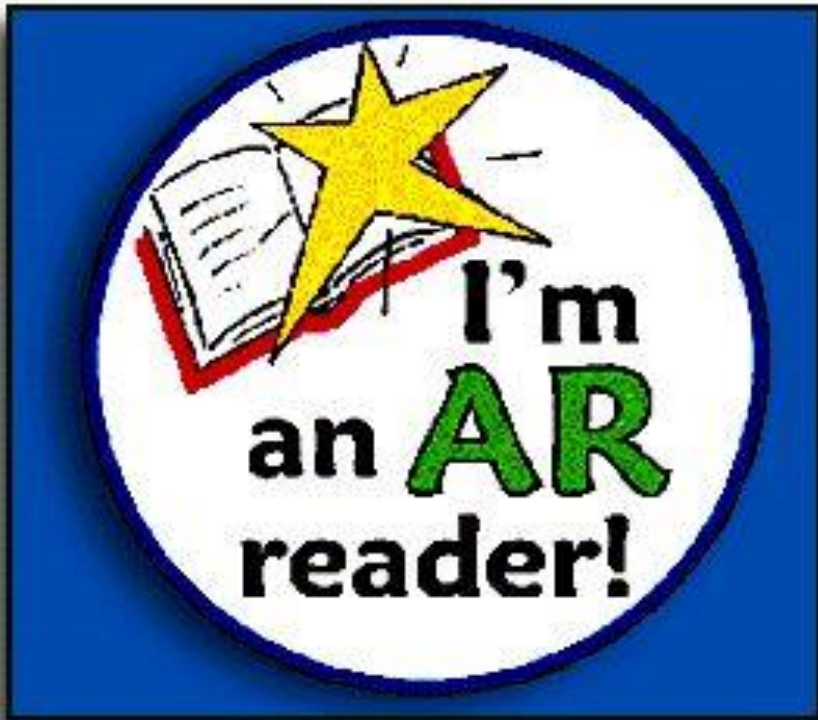
What happens if SARB requirements are not met?

The SARB case manager has the authority to refer the case to the District Attorney if trancies and unexcused absences continue to be a problem following the SARB hearing

Possible legal repercussions if prosecuted for truancy:

- Infraction/misdemeanor charges
- Fines
- Probation

Traffic Flow

Red Arrows - Cars may drop students off. Cars will pull all the way forward. STUDENTS MUST EXIT ON SIDEWALK SIDE ONLY. DRIVERS MUST STAY IN THE CAR AT ALL TIMES. Cars must stay in the same lane and exit right on Valle Vista Dr.

Purple arrows - Cars may drop students off at section B.

SECTION A - This is the crosswalk for students/parents to cross safely. Administration/teacher will be there to cross.

SECTION B - A second drop off option. Students must wait to use the crosswalk.

SECTION C - NO PARKING, NO DROP OFF, NO CROSSING, NO CHANGING LANES

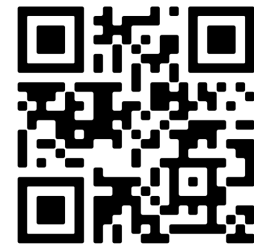

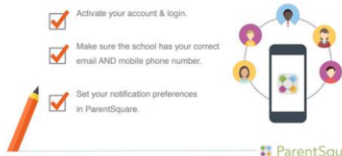

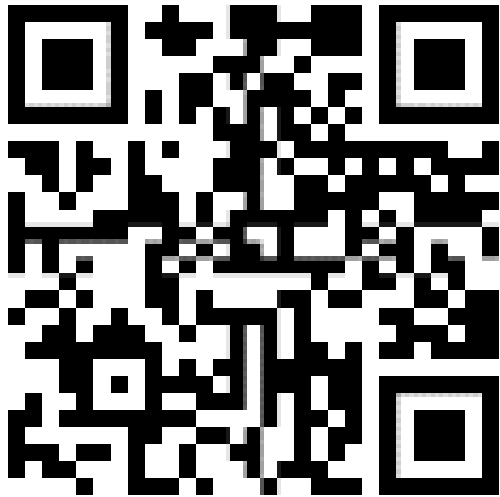
