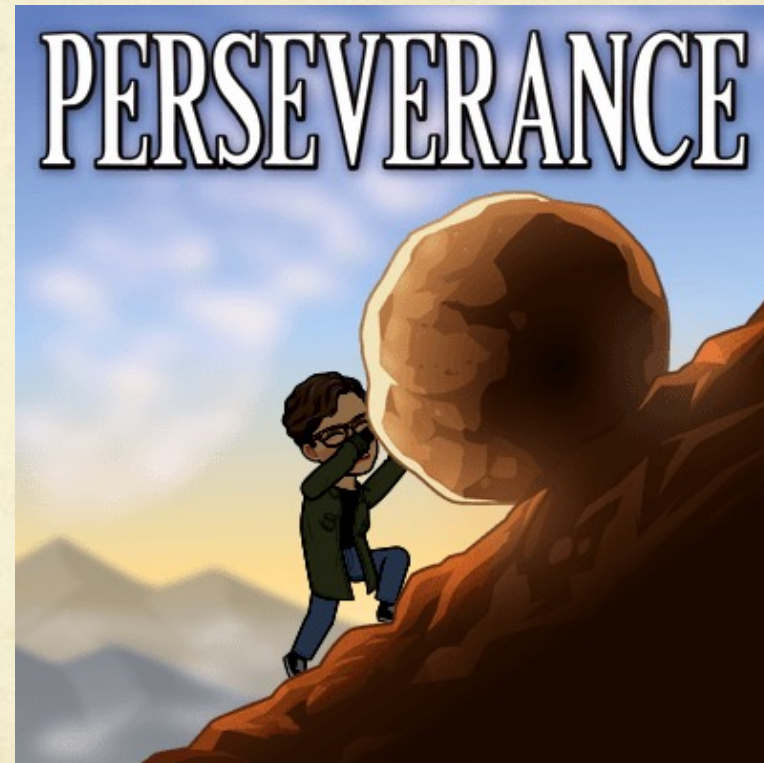
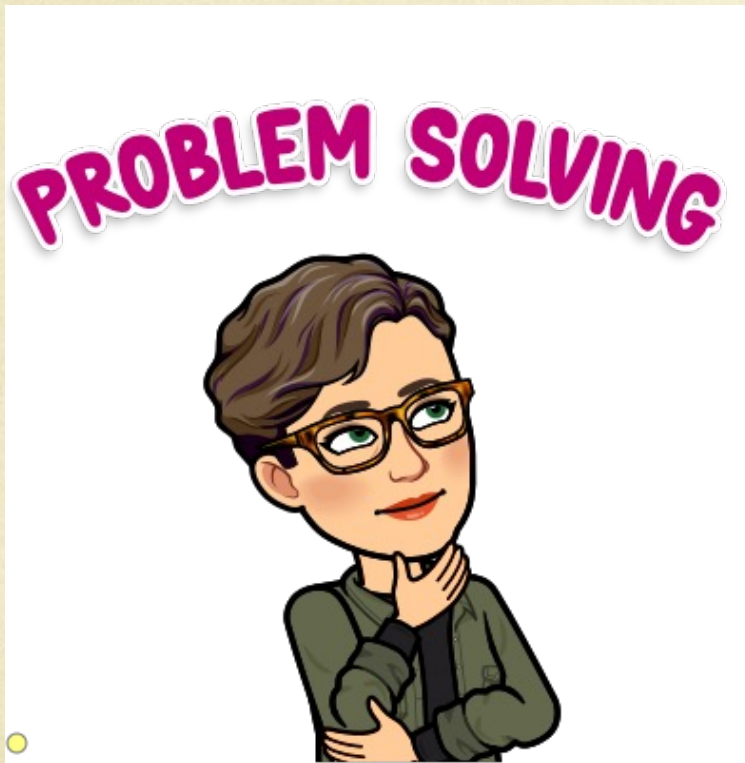

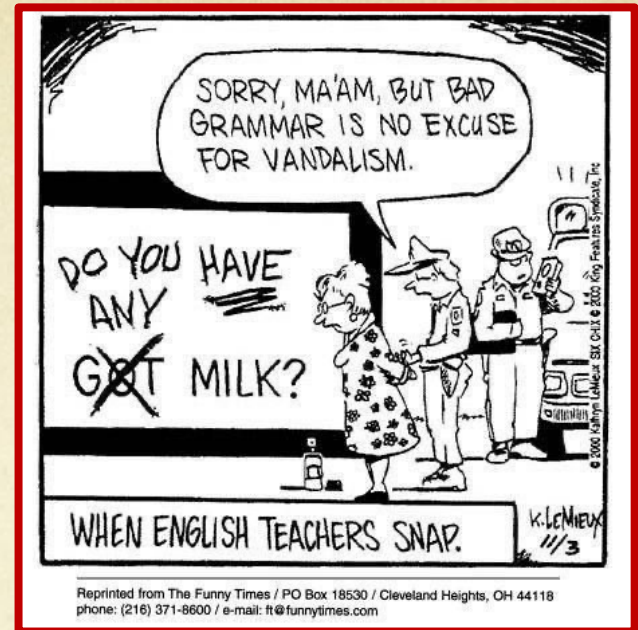
Philosophies Underpinning Course Outcomes

- Life is close reading
- Revision underscores all learning
- Reading, writing, learning are processes
- Learning is dialogic
- Voice & perspective should be developed & honored
- A rhetorical approach to communication is key
- Successful students develop successful habits
- Effective development in skills is relational
- Growth in learning involves reflection
- Engagement & asking the right questions are essential to learning

My Grading Philosophies

- ✓ Grades should primarily reflect skills, knowledge, achievement (not effort, completion)
- ✓ Focus on standards/outcomes means the most recent assessment is weighted more heavily at grade reporting times
- ✓ Focus on growth, spiraling concepts

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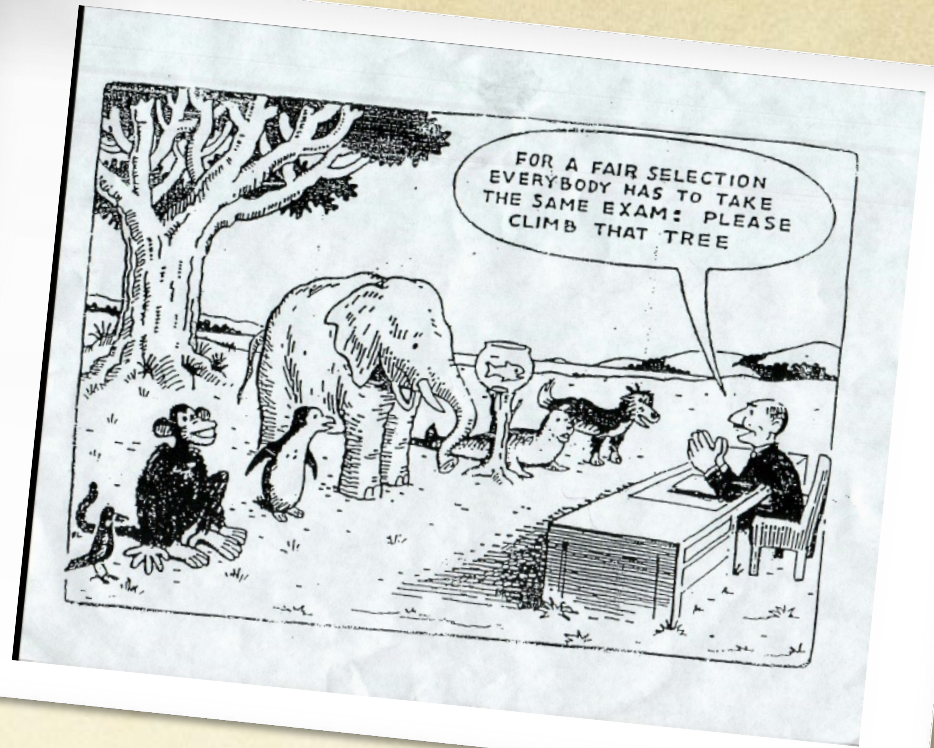


Learning is Trial, Error, & Hard Work

- Some work will be dropped

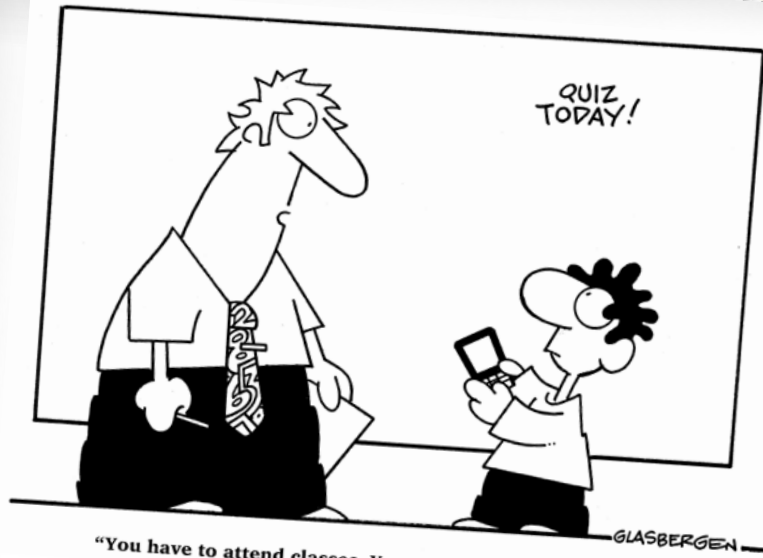

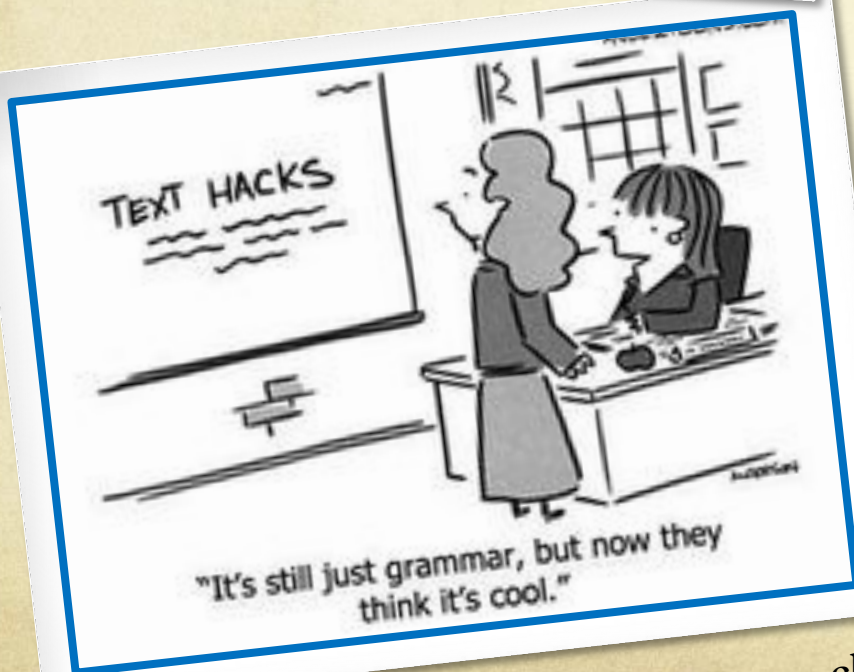
Learning Doesn't Always Look the Same

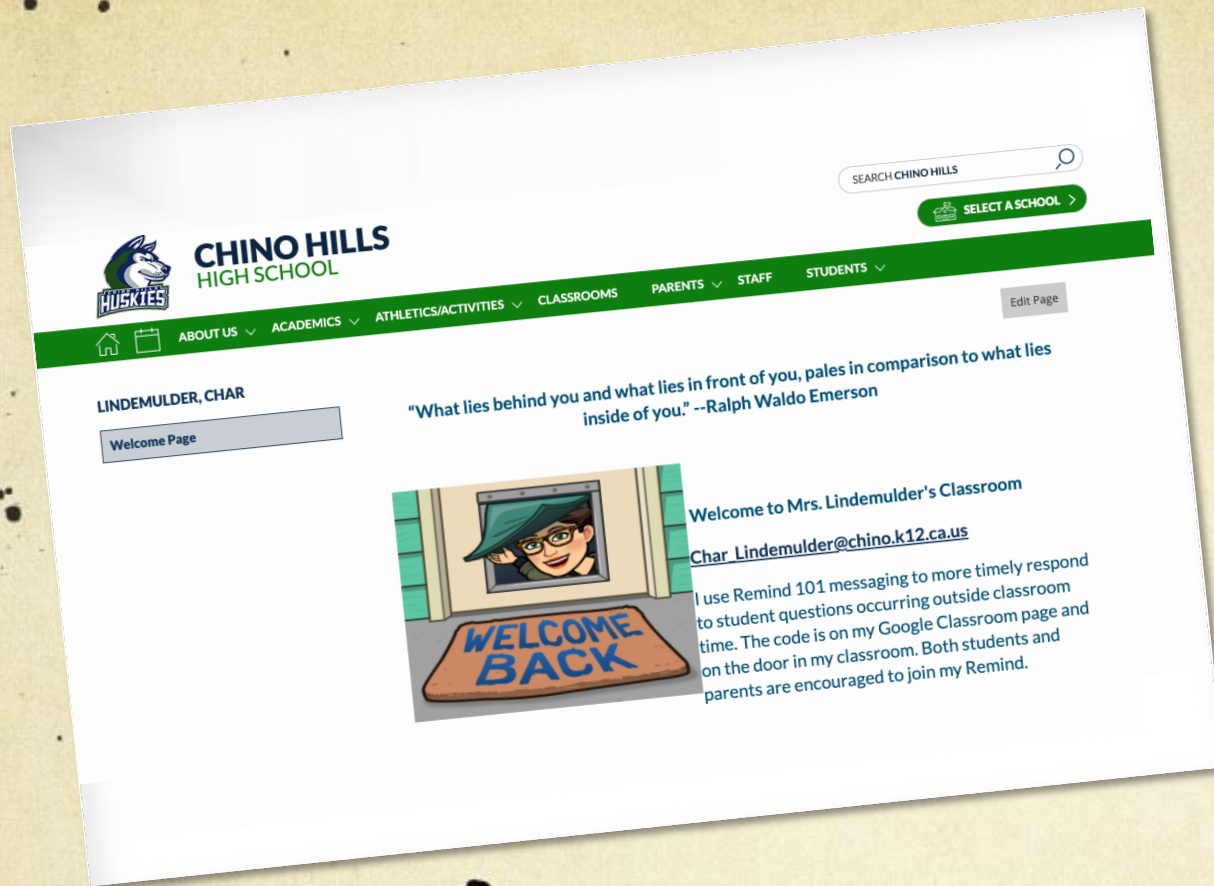

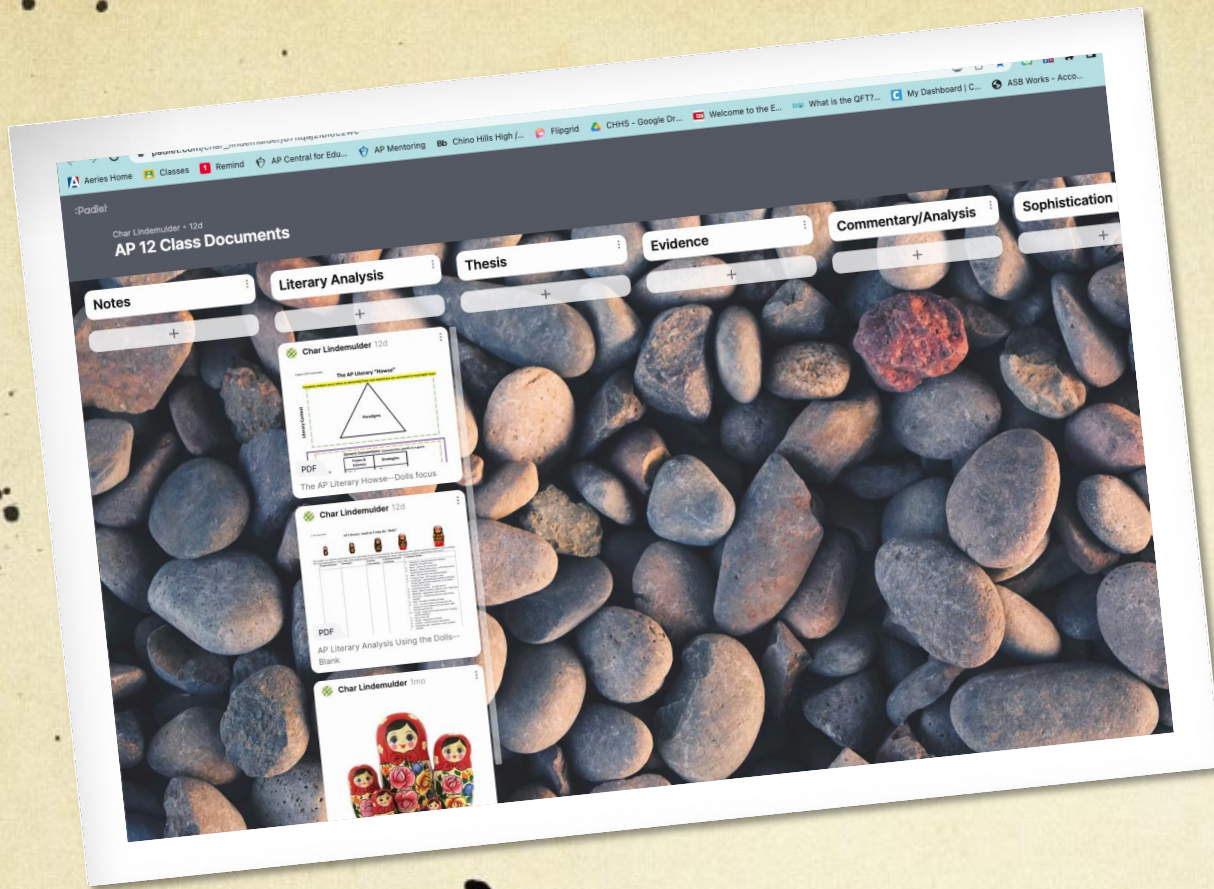
