In our fourth-grade *distance learning* classroom, I will engage all students with a vibrant learning climate and high-quality instruction. Here are some of the student learning strategies your child will use this year.

#### GOAL 1

#### GOAL 2

Communicate regularly with families about student learning, progress and behavior.

#### GOAL 3

We will teach vocabulary in depth across all content areas.

We will use research based best practices as we align our teaching to the California State Standards.

### At Home

I will provide these activities and/or supports at home to support my child's *distance learning* this year.

- Expect complete sentences when answering questions and in conversations.
- Ensure that your child reads on a nightly basis from books at their reading level.
- Your child should read his/her writing to you.
- Reinforce writing strategies learned in class.
- Ensure that homework reflects complete sentences and is turned in on time.
- Volunteer time in the classroom when available.
- Help plan and run 49er Day.
- Communicate with teacher as needed.
- Ensure that your child's backpack is clean, organized and that homework is checked nightly.
- Ensure that your child is at school, on time, each and every day.

### Distant Learning Expectations:

*I will do the following to support my own learning this year:*

- Log on a few minutes before class begins to be on time
- Stay engaged and logged into class the entire time
- Have a quiet work area and all necessary supplies (device charged)
- Complete homework and class assignments to the best of my ability
- Participate in classroom discussions and seek clarification from my teacher when I do not understand
